The Pojoaque Valley Community Planning Open House will provide an opportunity for the community to review and discuss the Pojoaque Community Plan Update and implementation which will include the draft Pojoaque Valley Overlay District and proposed zoning. You are invited to attend either of the meetings to review the material with your neighbors, members of the Pojoaque Planning Committee and Santa Fe County staff.

The Pojoaque Valley Community Plan update will be presented to the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) to be considered for adoption by Resolution as an update to the Sustainable Growth Management Plan. The proposed Pojoaque Valley Community District Overlay will be considered for adoption as part of the Sustainable Land Development Code (SLDC) amendment process. The proposed zoning will also be presented to the BCC to be considered for adoption as part of the Official Zoning Map.
