



ISSUE

The Santa Fe County Finance Division has received the Government Finance Officers Association Distinguished Budget Presentation Award for the fiscal year 2014 public budget document.

BACKGROUND

Each year Santa Fe County's Finance Division produces a public budget document which contains information regarding the current fiscal year's budget in addition to historical information, budget policies, departmental goals and performance measures as well as other relevant information. This document may then be submitted to the Government Finance Officers Association to be reviewed by an independent panel of reviewers and judged on nationally recognized guidelines as to how well the County's budget document serves as a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide and a communications device.

The award represents a significant achievement by the County and reflects its commitment to meeting the highest principles of governmental budgeting. The award is valid for a period of one year only. We believe our current budget continues to conform to program requirements and we will be submitting it to GFOA to determine its eligibility for another award.
