

Resolution No. 1999- /

A Resolution Calling For An Election To Be Held May 4, 1999 For The Purpose Of Electing Municipal Officers For The Town Of Edgewood

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 1998-123, the Board of County Commissioners called for a special election to be held January 5, 1999 for the purpose of determining whether the territory known as Edgewood and described in the Petition submitted to the Board of County Commissioners on July 29, 1998 should become an incorporated municipality;

WHEREAS, that Special Election was held on January 5, 1999; and


WHEREAS, the majority of votes cast were in favor of incorporation of the territory as a municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Santa Fe, that:

1. A Municipal Election for the election of municipal officers for the Town of Edgewood shall be held on Tuesday, May 4, 1999. The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.
2. At the Municipal Election, persons shall be elected to fill the following elective offices:
 - A. One Mayor at large to serve a term until the next Regular Municipal Election to be held the first Tuesday in March, 2000.
 - B. Four Council positions at large. The Councilors are to serve staggered four year terms. Two Councilors will serve until the next regular municipal election to be held the first Tuesday in March, 2000. Two Councilors will serve until the regular municipal election to be held the first Tuesday in March, 2002. After the election, there shall be a drawing by lot to determine which newly elected Councilors will serve until March 2000 and which ones will serve until March 2002.
 - C. One Municipal Judge to serve until the next Regular Municipal Election to be held the first Tuesday in March 2000.
3. Precincts 18 and 73 are consolidated for the Municipal Election.
4. The Edgewood Fire Station 1 shall be designated as the location for the polling place for the conduct of this election.

5. Voters must reside and be registered to vote within the Incorporated Town of Edgewood to be eligible to vote in this election.
6. Voting by Absentee ballot will begin on Thursday, March 25, 1999. 1590205
7. Absentee voting may be done in person in the Office of the County Clerk, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico, or eligible persons may submit an absentee ballot application to the Office of the County to request that a ballot be mailed from March 25, 1999 until Thursday, April 29, 1999.
8. Persons desiring to register to vote in the Municipal Election must register with the Santa Fe County Clerk not later than Tuesday, April 6, 1999, at 5:00 p.m., the date on which the County Clerk will close registration books.
9. All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the County Clerk and on a form provided by that office on Tuesday, March 9, 1999, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Only those candidates complying with these requirements shall be declared a candidate for any office in this election and only these candidates will appear on the ballot.
10. The casting of votes on election day by qualified municipal electors shall be recorded on AVC Voting Machines. Printed paper ballots will be used for Absentee Voting.
11. Canvass of the election results. The County Clerk shall complete the canvass of the election results no later than 5:00 p.m. May 8, 1999 to certify the results of the election and take any other necessary action relating to the election.




