A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SANTA FE PUBLIC SCHOOLS BRINGING THE BOND ISSUE BEFORE THE VOTERS ALLOCATING PROPERTY TAX FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF EXISTING AND THE BUILDING OF NEW PUBLIC SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Public Schools and the Board of Education have adopted the Citizens Review Committee recommendation to provide for capital outlay projects by bond election to obtain the maximum value of district capital outlay dollars, establish equity among school sites and provide accountability to the voters.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County recommends that Santa Fe Public Schools continue to improve our school classrooms by renovation, restoration, or replacement of existing buildings housing elementary and secondary students in the Santa Fe Public School District.

WHEREAS, Santa Fe Public Schools should continue promoting quality education as a top priority through the improvement of the structures where the education process prepares our future citizens.

WHEREAS, priority projects were assessed by the Citizens Review Committee and health and safety projects were considered of primary importance in the schools and were therefore, made a part of a facilities master plan slated to begin phase 1 construction in the year 2002 and phase 2 construction in the year 2005.

WHEREAS, the recommendation of these projects has been adopted by the New Mexico State School Board of Education and put forth by the Citizens Review Committee comprised of representation from the community by their association with business, charitable, government and school organizations.

WHEREAS, the Citizens Review Committee initiated this recommendation in September of 1997 and has systematically researched and solicited the consultation of professionals, examined schools in detail, and held public hearings in gathering data for their recommendation to assure that a fair and equitable recommendation was presented.

WHEREAS, the funding for these projects is based on residential property valuation and the impact on property owners has been clearly defined so that property owners will be adequately informed of the fiscal impact.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County supports bringing the Bond Issue that will provide the capital outlay for the completion of the Citizens Review Committee recommendation before the voters of Santa Fe. The projects will directly benefit northern New Mexicans, their families, and communities.
