### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COUNTY STAFF TO ASSIST CITY STAFF IN THEIR PURSUIT OF THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF BURRO ALLEY TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC.**

**WHEREAS,** Burro Alley is a one way through street located between Palace Avenue and San Francisco Street in downtown Santa Fe; and

**WHEREAS,** Burro Alley can only be accessed by vehicular traffic turning right from Palace Avenue; and

**WHEREAS,** in addition to vehicular traffic, Burro Alley has always been utilized by pedestrians as throughway from Palace Avenue to San Francisco Street; and

**WHEREAS,** there is an imposed danger to the community in continuing to allow vehicular traffic and pedestrian traffic through Burro Alley; and


**WHEREAS,** in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the community it is necessary to begin the process for Burro Alley to be permanently closed to vehicular traffic and become a pedestrian friendly throughway.

**NOW THEREFORE,** be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that in the interest of the health, safety

and welfare of the Community, staff is hereby authorized to begin the process in assisting the City of Santa Fe in beginning the process to permanently close Burro Alley to vehicular traffic.






