Resolution Number 1999-52

A Resolution Amending The Geographic Limits and Boundaries of Santa Fe County Fire Protection Districts

WHEREAS, Section 59A-53-5, NMSA, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of any county to establish one or more fire protection districts within the county, but outside the corporate limits of any city under certain terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Fire Protection Districts were established by Resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, a significant portion of geographic area within Santa Fe County and outside the corporate limits of any city lie outside the current established limits and boundaries of existing Santa Fe County Fire Protection Districts; and

WHEREAS, residential and commercial development continue to increase outside the limits and boundaries of existing Santa Fe County Fire Protection Districts; and

WHEREAS, residential and commercial development and citizens of Santa Fe County currently outside the limits and boundaries of existing Santa Fe County Fire Protection Districts deserve fire and emergency services protection; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Fire Protection Districts are willing to expand existing limits and boundaries to incorporate these unprotected areas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners having considered the facts, data and public input presented,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the geographic limits and boundaries of the following Santa Fe County Fire Protection Districts be amended as follows:

The existing **Agua Fria Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **Agua Fria Fire District** as follows:

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, Starting at the Rio Grande River in the Northwest corner of Section 36, T19N, R7E; thence east to that point where the Tesuque Pueblo Grant boundary intersects the northern line of section 32, T19, R8E, thence south along the Tesuque Pueblo Grant Boundary to its southern most point; thence east along the southern boundary of the Tesuque Pueblo Grant to the northeast corner of Section 29, T18N, R9 E; thence south to Alamo Creek Road; thence westerly to the end of Alamo Creek Road; thence easterly to Tierra De Tano; thence southwest to the west boundary of the City of Santa Fe Corporate limits; thence following the City / County boundary in a southerly direction until that boundary intersects with Airport Road in Section 7, T16N, R9E; thence southwesterly along the centerline of Airport Road to the northeast corner of the Santa Fe City Airport Boundary; thence west along the northern Airport boundary to that point where the Airport boundary, the Santa Fe River, and Section 10, T16N, R8E meet; thence southwest following the Santa Fe River to Section 16, T16N, R8E; thence westerly to the northwest corner of Section 15, T16N, R7E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 21, T16N, R7E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 19, T16N, R7E; thence northerly following the west boundary of Santa Fe County to the Rio Grande River; thence northeast following the Rio Grande River to the Northwest corner of Section 36, T19N, R7E.

The existing **Chimayo Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **Chimayo Fire District** as follows:

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, beginning where New Mexico state road 76 crosses the Santa Fe County / Rio Arriba County line, Section 3, T20N, R9E; thence easterly along the county boundary to the northeast corner of Section 3, T20N, R11E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 10, T20N, R11E; thence westerly to the northwest corner of Section 17, T20N, R11E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 19, T20N, R11E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 19, T20N, R11E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 12, T19N, R10E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 7, T19N, R10E; thence northerly to the southeast corner of Section 24, T20N, R9E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 23, T20N, R9E; thence northerly to the Arroyo Seco; thence westerly following the centerline of the Arroyo Seco to a point 920 ft east of the southwest corner of Section 15, T20N, R9E; thence northerly to where New Mexico state road 76 crosses the Santa Fe County / Rio Arriba County line, Section 3, T20N.

The existing **Edgewood Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **Edgewood Fire District** as follows:

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, beginning in the northwest corner of Section 18, T12N, R7E; thence easterly to the northeast corner of Section 18, T12N, R8E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 31, T10N, R8E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 31 T10N, R7E; thence northerly to the northwest corner of Section 18, T12N, R7E.

The existing **Eldorado Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **Eldorado Fire District** as follows:

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, beginning in the northwest corner of Section 3, T15N, R9E; thence easterly to the north bound easement of Interstate 25; thence southeasterly to US 84/285; thence southerly following the northbound easement of 84/285 for 2250

feet; thence southeasterly on a projected line to the end of Cougar Canyon road; thence southeasterly on a projected line to the southeast corner of Section 7, T14N, R11E; thence southeasterly on a projected line to the northeast corner of the San Cristobal Land Grant; thence southerly following the San Cristobal Land Grant to the south side of Section 16, T13N, R11E; thence westerly to the southbound easement of US 84/285; thence northerly to the San Cristobal Arroyo; thence westerly following the San Cristobal Arroyo to Piedra Alumbre Canyon; thence northerly following the Piedra Alumbre Canyon to the southbound easement of US 84/285; thence northwesterly to the centerline of the AT & SF railway track line; thence southwest along the centerline of the AT & SF track to the southwest corner of Section 23, T14N, R11E; thence northerly to the southeast corner of Section 15, T15N, R11E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 15, T15N, R11E; thence northerly to in the northwest corner of Section 3, T15N, R9E

The existing **Galisteo Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **Galisteo Fire District** as follows:

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, beginning in the northwest corner of Section 28, T14N, R9E; thence easterly to the northeast corner of Section 27, T14N, R9E; thence northeasterly following along the centerline of the AT & SF track to the southern boundary of Section 8, T14N, R10E; thence southeasterly following the southbound easement of US 84/285 to Piedra Alumbre Canyon; thence southerly following Piedra Alumbre Canyon to San Cristobal Arroyo; thence easterly following the San Cristobal Arroyo to the southbound easement of US 84/285; thence southerly to the southern boundary of Section 32, T12N, R11E; thence westerly to the San Cristobal Land Grant boundary in Section 34, T12N, R10E; thence northwesterly following the San Cristobal Land Grant boundary to the northern boundary of Section 29, T12N, R10E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 24, T12N, R8E; thence northerly to Section 36, T13N, R8E; thence easterly to the northwest corner of Section 32, T13N, R9E; thence northerly to the northwest corner of Section 32, T14N, R9E; thence easterly to the northeast corner of Section 32, T14N, R9E; thence northerly to the northwest corner of Section 28, T14N, R9E.

The existing **Glorieta Pass Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **Glorieta Pass Fire District** as follows:

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, beginning in the northwest corner of Section 19, T16N, R11E; thence easterly to the northeast corner of Section 24, T16N, R11E; thence southerly to Section 13, T15N, R11E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 17, T15N, R11E; thence northerly to the northwest corner of Section 5, T15N, R11E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 31, T16N, R11E; thence northerly to the northwest corner of Section 19, T16N, R11E.

The existing **Hondo Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **Hondo Fire District** as follows:

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, beginning at the point where the southbound easement of Interstate 25 crosses Richards Avenue; thence northeasterly following the southbound easement of Interstate 25 to the south boundary of the City of Santa Fe Corporate limits where Rodeo Road crosses US 84/285; thence following the south easement of Rodeo Road through the intersection of Old Pecos Trail; thence following the boundary of the City of Santa Fe Corporate limits to the end of Wilderness Gate Road in Section 4, T16N, R10E; thence on a projected line northeasterly 1080 feet to the township line dividing T17N and T16N; thence easterly following the township line dividing T17N and T16N to the northeast corner of Section 4, T16N, R10E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 4, T16N, R10E; thence easterly to the northeast corner of Section 11, T16N, R10E; thence southerly to the northwest corner of Section 36, T16N, R10E; thence easterly to the northeast corner of Section 36, T16N, R10E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 36, T16N, R11E; thence easterly to northeast corner of Section 6, T15N, R11E; thence southerly to the northeast corner of

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, beginning at the northwest corner of Section 30, T16N, R7E; thence easterly to the northwest corner of Section 27, T16N, R7E; thence northerly to the northwest corner of Section 15, T16N, R7E; thence easterly to the Santa Fe County Road 56; thence northeasterly following Santa Fe County Road 56 to the Airport boundary in Section 10, T16N, R8E ; thence southerly following the airport boundary; thence easterly following the airport boundary; thence northerly following the airport boundary to the intersection of New Mexico State Road 599 and Airport Road; thence easterly to the west boundary of the City of Santa Fe Corporate limits; thence southerly following the boundary of the City of Santa Fe Corporate limits to the southbound easement of Interstate 25 in Section 16, T16N, R9E; thence easterly following the southbound easement of Interstate 25 to the east boundary of Section 9, T16N, R9E; thence southerly to the southwest corner Section 15, T16N, R9E; thence easterly to the centerline of the Santa Fe Southern railway track line; thence southeasterly following the centerline of the Santa Fe Southern railway track line to the south boundary of Section 31, T16N, R10E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 33, T16N, R9E; thence northerly to the northwest corner of Section 33, T16N, R9E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 25, T16N, R8E; thence southerly to the northern boundary of the Penitentiary of New Mexico; thence westerly following the northern boundary of the Penitentiary of New Mexico; thence southeasterly following the west boundary of the Penitentiary of New Mexico; thence easterly following the southern boundary of the Penitentiary of New Mexico to the northeast corner Section 10, T15N, R8E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 15, T15N, R8E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 16, T15N, R7E; thence northerly to the northeast corner of Section 17, T15N, R8E; thence westerly to a point 500 feet from the southbound easement of East Frontage Road; thence westerly parallel to the southbound easement of East Frontage Road to northbound easement of Santa Fe County Road 57; thence northerly to the northbound easement of Interstate 25; thence westerly following the northbound easement of Interstate 25 to the west side boundary of Section 30, T15N, R7E; thence northerly to northwest corner of Section 30, T16N, R7E.

The existing **La Puebla Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **La Puebla Fire District** as follows:

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, beginning at a point 1728 feet east of the northeast corner of Section 1, T20N, R8E which is also the Corporate boundary of the City of Espanola; thence easterly to the point where New Mexico state road 76 crosses the Santa Fe County / Rio Arriba County line, Section 3, T20N, R9E; thence southerly on a projected line to a point 1210 feet east of Section 21, T20N, R8E at the Arroyo Seco; thence westerly following the Arroyo Seco to the west boundary of Section 17, T20N, R8E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 18, T20N, R8E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 13, T20N, R8E; thence northerly to the

Corporate boundary of the City of Espanola; thence following the Corporate boundary of the City of Espanola to a point 2600 feet east of the northeast corner of Section 1, T20N, R8E.

The existing **Madrid Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **Madrid Fire District** as follows:

All that certain tract of land situated in the county of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico, beginning at the intersection of the Santa Fe County line and the northbound easement of Interstate 25 in Section 30, T15N, R7E; thence easterly following the northbound easement of Interstate 25 to the east side of Section 21, T15N, R7E; thence southerly to the northwest corner of Section 22, T14N, R7E; thence easterly to the northeast corner of Section 22, T14N, R7E; thence southerly 2000 feet; thence on a projected line to the southeast corner of Section 24, T14N, R7E; thence southerly to the southeast corner of Section 12, T12N, R7E; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Section 7, T12N, R7E; thence northerly to the intersection of the Santa Fe County line and the northbound easement of Interstate 25 in Section 30, T15N, R7E.

The existing **Pojoaque Fire District** boundary is here by amended to establish the **Pojoaque Fire District** as follows:
