## *Resolution No. 1999-93*

---

### A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SANTA FE COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT PLANNING COMMITTEE

---

WHEREAS, the County Growth Management Plan addresses concern for management of development in the extraterritorial area and designates one New Community District, the Community College District; and

WHEREAS, the County Growth Management Plan designates Santa Fe County as the lead agency responsible for the development of a District Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County Growth Management Plan designates that a Community College District Planning Committee be established to guide the preparation of the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County Growth Management Plan designates that the Planning Committee include private property owners, government agencies, including the State Highway and Transportation Department, State Land Office and the City of Santa Fe, non-governmental organizations including churches and schools, and other community and neighborhood members from within the District; and

WHEREAS, the purposes of the Community College District Plan are to recommend specific ways in which infrastructure and community facilities can be built and maintained for the entire District; assure a connected open space and trails system; and create a balance of different types of land uses that are connected to transit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that:

1. The Community College District Planning Committee be established to prepare the Community College District Plan in conjunction with the Planning Division of Santa Fe County and provisions as outlined in the County Growth Management Plan.
2. The Community College District Planning Committee include members from Rancho Viejo Partnership, Rancho Viejo de Santa Fe, NM State

Land Office, Santa Fe Community College, Santa Fe Southern Railroad, Institute of American Indian Arts, Santa Fe Public Schools, the city of Santa Fe, Representatives of existing neighborhoods including the Richards Avenue/Dinosaur Trail and E. Frontage Rd. Area, Arroyo Hondo West, SR 14/Turquoise Trail Area, the Old Agua Fria Road Area, and other neighborhood areas appropriate to meet the goals and objectives of the Santa Fe County Growth Management Plan.
