**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SANTA FE URBAN AND EXTRATERRITORIAL FUTURE ROADS PLAN (WITH MAP) AND INCORPORATING IT INTO THE SANTA FE COUNTY GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN.**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Arterial Roads Task Force (ARTF) was convened by the Extraterritorial Zoning Authority in December 1992 to carry out a community-based review of the region's future road plans and to propose amendments to those plans; and

**WHEREAS**, between May 1993 and May 1999 approximately 40 public meetings were held of the ARTF ad hoc citizen's committee facilitated by City and County staff with the participation of over 300 County and City citizens, representing over 50 neighborhoods, land owners, civic groups, developers and private planners; and

**WHEREAS**, the ARTF, with the support of City and County planning staffs, performed a detailed review and analysis of nearly 100 alternative road networks using detailed estimates of the likely location, character and intensity of future development (using TModel 2 traffic simulation computer model) as a basis for evaluating proposed roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1998 an ARTF Steering Committee was convened and produced a Final Plan report on May 3, 1999; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Santa Fe Urban and Extraterritorial Future Roads Plan was presented and reviewed at a public hearing on May 19, 1999 and officially adopted with some modification on May 27, 1999 by the Transportation Policy Board (TPB); and

**WHEREAS**, the TPB-approved Santa Fe Urban and Extraterritorial Future Roads Plan was presented to the four planning committees with jurisdiction in the area covered by the Plan on June 16, 1999 and approved with some modifications by the City Planning Commission and the Agua Fria Development Review Committee on that date, by the Extraterritorial Zoning Commission on July 8, 1999, and by the County Development Review Committee on July 29, 1999; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held before a joint special session of the Board of County Commissioners and the Santa Fe City Council on August 17, 1999; and

WHEREAS, this is a true metropolitan region planning issue and the Board wishes to acknowledge the commitment and effort of so many citizens and neighborhoods and the cooperative efforts of City and County staff in developing this Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that:

1. The Santa Fe Urban And Extraterritorial Future Roads Plan, as amended by the Transportation Policy Board (with map), attached as Exhibit A to this Resolution, is hereby adopted and incorporated into the Santa Fe County Growth Management Plan; and
2. Any amendments, deletions or additions to this Future Road Plan be reviewed for recommendation by the appropriate planning committees, including the Steering Committee of the ARTF, and affected neighbors and property owners prior to adoption.






