A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE TELEVISED BROADCAST OF ALL REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY

Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County is the principal governing body of the County of Santa Fe;

Whereas, Twice every month, the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners conducts the business of the people through regularly scheduled public hearings;

Whereas, it is to the benefit of the public and to our democracy that the deliberations of the Board of County Commissioners are easily accessible to its citizens;

Whereas, the County of Santa Fe encompasses over 2000 square miles and attendance at the meetings of the Board of County Commissioners can be difficult for Santa Fe County citizens;

Whereas, modern technology allows the dissemination of vital information to the public through televised broadcast;

Whereas, elective bodies around the country have used the televised broadcast of their meetings with success;

Whereas, The televised broadcast of meetings of the Board of County Commissioners will assist in providing information to voters and result in a more informed citizenry;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of the public to broadcast via television the proceedings of all regularly scheduled meetings of the Board of County Commissioners and directs the County Manager to proceed as follows:

1. Direct staff to research and apply the available technology to begin the televised broadcast of regularly scheduled meetings of the Board of County Commissioners.
2. Set guidelines for the use of televised broadcast meetings of the regularly scheduled meetings of the Board of County Commissioners.
3. In a timely manner, begin the televised broadcast of regularly scheduled meetings of the Board of County Commissioners.
