A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING EFFORTS TO PREVENT AND REDUCE THE ABUSE OF BLACK TAR HEROIN IN SANTA FE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the abuse of black tar heroin results in the death of many citizens in Santa Fe County each year; and

WHEREAS, the abuse of black tar heroin is a regional problem; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County staff members and staff members of Rio Arriba County, as well as the Eight Northern Indian Pueblos have been collaborating on the Black Tar Heroin Prevention Steering Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Black Tar Heroin Steering Committee makes periodic reports to the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, there has been demonstrated value in addressing the problem of black tar heroin abuse on a regional basis; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Health has provided funding for the ongoing work prioritized by the Steering Committee in addressing the black tar heroin problem;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners that it supports the efforts of the Black Tar Heroin Prevention Steering Committee and will endeavor to provide staff support as needed to the Steering Committee and it's work.






