A Resolution Supporting the Creation of the North East Connector Route as an alternate access for the Community College District.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the Community College Plan and Ordinance in December 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Plan and the Ordinance adopted a Road Circulation Plan which designates the roads necessary for the free flow of traffic in the Community College District; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission has contracted with Al Pitts to do a road study of the District roads set out in the Community College Circulation Plan; and

WHEREAS, once the traffic study by Al Pitts is completed, the County will request adoption of the Community College Circulation Plan as an amendment to the Arterial Road Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County in the Community College Circulation Plan designated a road that connected St. Francis Drive, through Old Agua Fria Road and into the Community College District (hereinafter known as the "North East Connector") as an additional access for the Community College District; and

WHEREAS, the North East connector is important to the free flow of traffic and as an additional ingress and egress to the Community College District; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission agrees that the construction and implementation of roads in the Community College that will alleviate traffic on Richards Avenue and provide an alternate access for the Community College; and

WHEREAS, the alignment for the NE Connector is being studied by the State Highway Department and the interested parties; and

WHEREAS, the State Highway Department desires to work with the County to complete the studies necessary for the completion of the NE connector; and

WHEREAS, the State Highway Department will require that the County commit

to accepting a dedication of the North East Connector and taking over the operation and maintenance of the road; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission is committed to working with the State Highway Department to implement the North East Connector as an alternate and additional ingress and egress for the Community College.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners ("BCC") of Santa Fe County that:

1. The BCC shall appoint the Public Works Department as the designated agent for the BCC to work on behalf of the County with the Highway and Transportation Department and any and all interested parties for the creation and completion of the North East Connector.

1. The BCC is committed to the intent of the Community College and the Circulation Plan and is committed to provide an additional and alternate access for the Community College District.

2. The BCC shall accept the NE Connector road upon completion and when the road has met the County road standards.





