ORDINANCE NO. 2002-7

(REPLACING EXHIBIT "A" OF SANTA FE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 1988-11)

**CREATING A ROAD ADVISORY COMMITTEE; ESTABLISHING
GEOGRAPHICAL AREAS OF REPRESENTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF
CITIZEN INPUT FROM ALL COMMUNITIES WITHIN SANTA FE COUNTY**

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to identify and plan road improvement projects for Santa Fe County, by establishing a mechanism whereby citizen input is allowed and concerns are addressed.

Section 2. Committee Created -- Membership -- Appointment -- Terms

There is created a Road Advisory Committee. The committee shall be composed of fifteen (15) members, one from each geographical area of the county as enumerated in the amended Exhibit "A". Members shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Board of County Commissioners for terms of three (3) years, staggered so that the terms of five (5) members expires December 31 of each year or until their successors have been duly appointed and qualified. In making the initial appointments after the adoption of this ordinance, five (5) members shall be appointed for terms expiring on December 31, 1989; five (5) members expiring on December 31, 1990 and five (5) members for terms expiring on December 31, 1991. A Chairman shall be selected by the committee in January of each year. Once elected, the Chairman shall serve for a term ending on December 31 of the same year. The Committee may select such other officers as it deems appropriate.

Section 3. Vacancies

A vacancy shall exist upon the death, removal, resignation, or change of residence from the geographical area represented by the member. Vacancies on the committee shall be filled by the Board of County Commissioners for the unexpired term of the member creating the vacancy, and shall be from the same geographical area as the member who created the vacancy.

Section 4. Duties of the Committee

The Committee shall:

1. Review and recommend road improvements to the Board of County Commissioners.
2. Review and monitor road improvement projects.
3. Research funding sources in order to establish long-range planning for road improvements.
4. Serve as liaison between the Board of County Commissioners and the general public.
5. Develop and recommend construction standards for existing county roads.
6. Meet at least once a month at a regularly scheduled time and place, giving proper notice of each meeting.

Section 5. Alternate Members -- Quorum

A quorum of the committee shall be eight (8) members. A quorum is required to exercise the powers granted herein. In order to maintain a quorum at all meetings, the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint an alternate for each member to serve in their place with all rights and privileges, including matters submitted to the committee for consideration. Alternates shall be appointed by and serve the same terms, and be from the same geographical area as the member for whom they are representing on the committee.

Section 6. Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective on June 1, 2002.


Road Advisory Designated Areas

Santa Fe County


