19 Vazquez. The Court heard evidence and testimony presented by the County and the Interested Party, and
20 being fully advised,

21 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:**

22 1. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter thereto;
23 2. The County established by a preponderance of the evidence that the \$601.00 in U. S.
24 Currency, was found within the vehicle used by Mr. Clyde Vigil, and was used to facilitate the sale of
25 narcotics. Any and all right, title, and interest in the money, which Mr. Vigil and Ms. Sanchez, or any
26 other person may claim, is hereby FORFEITED;

27 3. The County established by a preponderance of the evidence that the 1985 Chevrolet
28 Monte Carlo was used to transport and facilitate the sale of narcotics by Mr. Vigil;

The Plaintiff, Santa Fe County, ex. rel., Santa Fe County Sheriff's Department, was represented by Assistant County Attorney Rosanna C. Vazquez. Interested Party Herman Padilla did not attend the trial but was represented by John Paul Gallegos. Ms. Rita Padilla, Herman Padilla's mother, was present at trial and was represented by John Paul Gallegos for her interest in the property which is the subject matter of this action.

The Court heard evidence and testimony presented by the State and the Interested Party,
and being fully advised:


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter thereto;
2. The County established by a preponderance of the evidence that Ms. Rita Padilla is not an innocent owner of the property and her ownership interest is **FORFEITED**;
3. Ms. Rita Padilla's failure to answer the complaint as an Interested Party constitutes a default;
4. Herman Padilla's failure to appear at the forfeiture trial constitutes a waiver of his rights to the seized property; and
5. All right, title and interest in the property, which is the subject matter of this action which Herman Padilla, or any other persons may claim, be and the same hereby is, **FORFEITED** to the Santa Fe County Sheriff's Department, Santa Fe, New Mexico.
