Declaration of Disaster for Santa Fe County Ditches and Acequias

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Fe has experienced heavy rainfall, especially in the Chimayo area, on or about July 26, 2003, resulting in flooding and extensive damage to the Maestas Ditch, the Acequia Barela, and others; and

WHEREAS, these ditches and Acequias are public entities established under the provisions of Chapter 73, Sections 2 and 3, NMSA 1978; and

WHEREAS, the flooding has resulted in undue human suffering and hardship and threatened the safety, health and well-being of the citizens of Santa Fe County and has impaired the economic functions of the county; and

WHEREAS, all locally available public and private resources and forces available to mitigate and alleviate the damage are deemed insufficient to cope with the resulting situation;

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Santa Fe County Board of Commissioners do hereby declare that an emergency situation exists in Santa Fe County ditches and Acequias.




