## Resolution No. 2003 - 172

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### A RESOLUTION REQUESTING FUNDING THROUGH THE 2003/2004 NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATIONS LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM

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WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (hereafter referred to as "the Board") desires to utilize funding made available through an application submitted to the New Mexico Department of Transportation's Local Government Road Fund Program for road improvements to County Road 8;

WHEREAS, the application was approved by the New Mexico Department Of Transportation (hereafter referred to as "the Department") and funding will be received in the form of three Cooperative Agreements SB-7765 (946), SP-5-04 (922) and CAP-5-04 (416);

WHEREAS, the Department requires that the Board submit a resolution requesting funding and providing a detailed project breakdown per each Cooperative Agreement; and

WHEREAS, a detailed project breakdown, together with the agreed County match, is set forth on Exhibit A herein for each of three sections comprising the County Road 8 (Dinkle Road) project.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the matching set forth in Exhibit A for the 2003/2004 New Mexico Department of Transportations Local Government Road Fund Program based on the requested project amounts and quantities listed herein.
