A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE COMMUNITY OF CHIMAYO A WATER EMERGENCY SITUATION

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners on May 27, 2003, the following was among the proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners acknowledge that the Community of Chimayo through the Greater Chimayo Mutual Domestic Water Association is experiencing emergency situations whereas they cannot supply the drinking water needed for their community and have requested assistance from the Santa Fe County Commissioners along with the State of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners recognize that the community of Chimayo is experiencing problems with supplying an adequate source of drinking water; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners also recognize that water is necessary for the health and well being of the Community of Chimayo; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners also recognize that the water emergency is a threat to the health and well being of the Community of Chimayo,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE SANTA FE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS do hereby declare that a water emergency situation exists in the Community of Chimayo,
