Resolution No. 2003 - 82

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY PLANNING COMMITTEE, AUTHORIZATION TO INITIATE A COMMUNITY PLANNING PROCESS AND ESTABLISHMENT OF INITIAL PLANNING BOUNDARIES FOR THE VILLAGE OF AGUA FRIA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners designated the Village of Agua Fria as a Traditional Historic Community via Ordinance 1995-8 and amended the Village of Agua Fria Traditional Historic Community boundary via Ordinance 1996-16; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Agua Fria is designated as a Traditional Community through the Santa Fe County Land Use Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the County Growth Management Plan on October 26, 1999, in part to plan areas of Santa Fe County that are designated as Traditional Communities; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Land Use Code and the County Growth Management Plan define Traditional Communities as settlement areas with "(1) 75 or more years of continuous settlement; (2) an historic pattern of land use or development; (3) historic structures; and (4) existence of village center or centers"; and

WHEREAS, the County Growth Management Plan recognizes that "a thorough understanding of the design and planning elements on which Traditional Community is based is not only a resource for the community, but also a model for future development in the county"; and

WHEREAS, the County Growth Management Plan recognizes the need for the "communities [to] develop community plans which incorporate growth policies which coordinate land use and water management decisions, consistent with the desires of the community residents"; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County Ordinance No. 2002-3, also known as the Community Planning Ordinance, outlines the community planning process for the development of Community Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Community Planning Ordinance outlines a planning process that includes participation and representation, establishment of a planning committee, and initial community planning boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Agua Fria has met the requirements of the Community Planning Ordinance to request the initiation of a community planning process; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2003, the Agua Fria Development Review Committee unanimously recommended that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the initiation of a community planning process, the establishment of the planning committee, and the initial planning boundary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that:

- 1) The Village of Agua Fria Community Planning Committee is established with an initial membership as identified. (Exhibit 1)
- 2) The Village of Agua Fria Planning Committee is authorized to initiate a planning process to prepare a Community Plan that is consistent with the Community Planning Ordinance and County Growth Management Plan.
- 3) The Village of Agua Fria Traditional Historic Community Boundary, as amended, map is recognized as the initial Village of Agua Fria planning boundary. (Exhibit 2)


