RESOLUTION NO. 2004 - 109

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A PORTION OF ENTRADA DE SANTIAGO FOR COUNTY MAINTENANCE

Whereas, Santa Fe County encompasses a geographical area of approximately 2,000 square miles; and

Whereas, Santa Fe County is primarily rural with small areas of concentrated development; and

Whereas, a comprehensive road system is a necessary and vital link between communities; and

Whereas, there are an estimated 1,500 total miles of roads within Santa Fe County; and

Whereas, of the total miles, approximately 592 miles are recognized as County Roads and maintained by the County of Santa Fe (the "County"); and

Whereas, the County's goal is to provide the best services possible to Santa Fe County residents, within the available resources; and

Whereas, Entrada de Santiago is located within Santa Fe County; and

Whereas, the residents of the Santiago Subdivision have asked the County to accept and provide maintenance on a portion of Entrada de Santiago; and

Whereas, the County has the authority and capability to accept this road for maintenance; and

Whereas, the residents of the Santiago Subdivision have met all the requirements in the Road Acceptance Policy, Resolution 1998-119; and

Whereas, the County conducted an inspection of this road and determined that Entrada de Santiago does meet County standards, with the exception of the divided section of roadway that does not meet sight distance requirements; and

Whereas, the residents of the Santiago Subdivision have acquired legislative appropriations in the amount of \$40,000 for drainage and paving improvements; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Santa Fe ("BCC") finds it to be in the best interest of the residents of Santa Fe County to accept a portion of Entrada de Santiago.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BCC accepts for County maintenance the portion of Entrada de Santiago, a base course road, beginning at the intersection with Rabbit Road and ending at the intersection with Calle Jacinta, a distance of 0.30 miles, subject to the following conditions:

- The County shall remove the divided section of Entrada de Santiago.
- The County shall not begin maintenance of Entrada de Santiago until after the drainage and paving improvements have been completed.
- Santa Fe County does not accept any maintenance responsibility for residential driveways or drainage structures on driveways. It is advisable that residents repair damaged culverts and reinstall culverts to the proper flow line elevation. In the event that improper installation or lack of maintenance of drainage structures causes damage to the County maintained road, the County reserves the right to collect damages for repair against the responsible party.
