

1 respective service areas; and

2 **WHEREAS**, the demand for these same services is rising throughout Northern New
3 Mexico; and

4 **WHEREAS**, there is currently no local recycling facility available to the parties which
5 can cost-effectively support these efforts and assist them in accomplishing their respective
6 recycling goals; and

7 **WHEREAS**, all three parties wish to increase the value of the materials they collect for
8 recycling as well as the volume of material they collect.

9 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
10 **SANTA FE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AGENCY, THE SANTA FE CITY**
11 **COUNCIL AND THE SANTA FE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** that

12 Section 1. The three parties shall utilize their combined resources to increase
13 recycling within their existing solid waste management systems.

14 Section 2. That a Material Recovery Facility (MRF) be developed by the three
15 parties which will process and market recyclable materials collected by the three parties.

16 Section 3. That the City Of Santa Fe Solid Waste Transfer Station has been
17 identified as the ideal location for the MRF, however unknown factors may preclude it from
18 being utilized for this purpose.

19 Section 4. That all three parties coordinate, plan and budget appropriate funding and
20 personnel for the planning and design of a MRF with all appropriate agencies and personnel.

21 Section 5. That all three parties will support and pursue alternative funding sources
22 for the project including but not limited to the State of New Mexico, various federal agencies and
23 various private foundations.

24 Section 6. That additional recycling efforts such as scrap tires, scrap metal and green
25 waste be consolidated at the MRF site.

1 Section 7. That the SFSWMA will be the operator and manager of the MRF,
2 regardless of location.

3 Section 8. That all three parties establish a goal of reaching a 20% diversion rate,
4 based on annual tonnage received at the Caja del Rio Landfill and all material recycled by the
5 three parties, by July 1, 2006.



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


