A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF SANTA FE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LOCAL DWI CARE CONNECTION / DETOX PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Legislature enacted NMSA 1978, Sections 11-6A-1 through 11-6A-6 to address the serious problems caused by Driving While Intoxicated ("DWT") in the State;

WHEREAS, a program is established by the State of New Mexico to make grant and distribution funding available to counties and municipalities for new, innovative or model programs, services or activities to prevent or reduce the incidence of DWI, alcoholism and alcohol abuse;

WHEREAS, approval of Santa Fe County's DWI Planning Council and other governmental entities must be received in order to apply for grant and distribution funding; and

WHEREAS, the County, along with participating agencies, will apply to the Department of Finance and Administration, Local Government Division for program funding.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that the County Chairperson, on behalf of the County is authorized to submit an application for grant and distribution program funding under the regulations established by the Local Government Division.




