RESOLUTION NO. 2005-108

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NEGATIVE REFERENDUM  
OPTION FOR THE ONE-SIXTEENTH PERCENT COUNTY GROSS RECEIPTS TAX

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 7-20E-9(D)(2004) permits a County to impose a one-sixteenth percent county gross receipts tax, the revenue from which may be dedicated to general purposes;

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 7-20E-3 (2004) permits the governing body of a County enacting a Local Option Gross Receipts Tax to select either a negative or positive referendum on the question of approving or disapproving a tax ordinance; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County, New Mexico, desires to adopt the one-sixteenth percent county gross receipts tax using the negative referendum option, as provided by Law.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, AS FOLLOWS:

The Board of County Commissioners adopts the negative referendum option described in NMSA 1978, Section 7-20E-3 (2004), in its adoption of the One-sixteenth Percent County Gross Receipts Tax.
