

SANTA FE COUNTY RESOLUTION #2005-112

Resolution Directing and Authorizing Santa Fe County to Participate in the NACO Prescription Drug Discount Card Program

WHEREAS, according to the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Studies the cost of pharmaceutical prescriptions have increased 137% between 1993 and 2000; and

WHEREAS, according to "Insure New Mexico's" Report to the Governor, 22.1% of New Mexicans do not have even basic health insurance; and

WHEREAS, many Santa Fe County residents have no insurance for, and need financial help to procure, prescribed pharmaceuticals; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties has developed a prescription drug discount card program that Santa Fe County may participate in as a dues paying member; and

WHEREAS, the program appears to be little or no cost to Santa Fe County; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners wishes to assist its uninsured citizens attain needed medication.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners directs Santa Fe County staff to proceed to explore and negotiate a contractual relationship with the NACO Prescription Drug Discount Program for Santa Fe County residents.
