Resolution No. 2005 - 46

A Resolution in Support of Maintaining Current Funding Levels for Federal Workforce Investment Act Programs

WHEREAS, Maintaining adequate funding for the workforce system is urgently needed if local workforce programs are going to meet their commitment to the millions of Americans in need of work, in need of skills upgrading so that they can continue to work, and in need of general assistance finding a new job;

WHEREAS, Congress has significantly reduced funding for the Workforce Investment Act programs since fiscal year 2003, with overall reduction amounts to approximately 15 percent;

WHEREAS, The Bush Administration's budget would further reduce funding during fiscal year 2006;

WHEREAS, Adult employment and training programs would be funded at \$866 million, a decrease of \$25 million over current funding;

WHEREAS, Dislocated worker employment and training activities would be funded at \$1.350 billion, close to an eight percent reduction over current funding, and youth programs would be funded at \$950 million, a cut of \$36 million;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County hereby supports funding of the Workforce Investment Act by maintaining at least current levels as well as additional funding for the Community-based Job Training Grants Initiatives.






