**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING
THROUGH TRUCK TRAFFIC ON CAJA DEL RIO ROAD IN
SANTA FE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, §66-7-415 (2003) permits a local government to enact ordinances to prohibit operation of trucks or other commercial vehicles or to impose limitations as to the size or weight thereof on designated streets in areas that are primarily residential and under the local government's jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Caja del Rio Road is a Santa Fe County adopted and maintained public road;

WHEREAS, north of Wildlife Way up to Las Campanas Drive is primarily residential with dwelling units;

WHEREAS, north of Wildlife Way, with the exception of the Marty Sanchez Golf Course is primarily residential with dwelling units;


WHEREAS, south of Wildlife Way to SR 599 is zoned agricultural and residential, and primarily is vacant;

WHEREAS, the proximity of the Caja del Rio Landfill and related truck traffic necessitate through truck traffic restrictions in certain primarily residential areas with dwelling units located on Caja del Rio Road.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners adopt an ordinance restricting through truck traffic on Caja del Rio Road.


