Resolution No. 2006 - 75

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NEW MEXICO RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM FOR THE ACQUISITION OF THE ATALAYA MOUNTAIN / PARKER PROPERTY ACQUISITION PROJECT

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County ("County") intends to purchase approximately 103 acres of land known as the Atalaya Mountain / Parker property for inclusion in the County's open space and trails property inventory and has applied for a funding grant from the New Mexico Recreational Trails Program (RTP) to assist with such acquisition; and

WHEREAS, the federal Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient, Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) has funded the RTP; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Energy, Minerals, and Natural Resources Department (EMNRD), State Parks Division has been assigned the responsibility for the administration of the RTP grant program; and

WHEREAS, the procedures established in the RTP grant program require a resolution certifying the approval of application(s) by the Applicant's governing board; and

WHEREAS, County, if its grant application is approved, will enter into an appropriate agreement with the State of New Mexico to carry out the grant related to the Atalaya Mountain / Parker Property Acquisition Project ("Project").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Santa Fe hereby:


1. Authorizes the submission of an application to the RTP for a grant related to the Project;
2. Certifies that the County, as the Project sponsor, has matching funds available to complete the Project within the grant term, which is anticipated to be five (5) years from the date of the grant award;
3. Certifies that the County, as the future landowner, will ensure public access to the proposed recreational trail improvements funded, in part, by the grant for a minimum of 25 years;
4. Certifies that the Project will (i) comply with applicable laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, and disabled access laws, and (ii) that all applicable permits will be obtained prior to commencement of construction; and

- 5. Appoints the Director of the County's Open Space and Trails Division, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations and execute and submit all documents that may be necessary or appropriate for the implementation, administration, and/or completion of the RTP grant for the Project, including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, payment requests, and the like.




