**RESOLUTION NO. 2007 63**

**A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING TRUCK TRAFFIC ON CAMINO CARLOS RAEI BEWEEN THE CITY AND COUNTY LIMITS OF SANTA FE AND ITS INTERSECTIONS WITH AGUA FRIA AND WEST ALAMEDA STREETS; DIRECTING POSTING ON SAID INTERSECTIONS AND CAMINO CLARLOS RAEI AND DIRECTING STAFF TO FORWARD A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, MOTOR TRANSPORTATION DIVISION.**

**WHEREAS**, Camino Carlos Rael is a residential street measuring less than .5 miles and is located between two heavily traveled arteries of Agua Fria and West Alameda Streets; and

**WHEREAS**, heavy trucks, truck trailers and other larger vehicles are regularly traveling on Camino Carlos Rael to cross between the intersections of Agua Fria and West Alameda, creating unacceptable noise, safety and pollution; and

**WHEREAS**, heavy trucks, truck trailers and other larger vehicles disrupt the community and affect the quality of life of residents who live along Camino Carlos Rael; and

**WHEREAS**, Camino Carlos Rael is not a designated truck and truck trailer route, and reasonable alternate routes exist for trucks and commercial motor vehicles to travel from the intersection of Agua Fria and West Alameda Streets; and

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 66-7-415 (1955) gives the Board of County Commissioners the authority, by resolution or ordinance, to restrict trucks and commercial motor vehicles on designated streets in areas that are primarily residential, which prohibitions and limitations shall be designated by appropriate signs placed on such streets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners desires to impose such restrictions on Camino Carlos Rael and to direct staff to place appropriate signs detailing the restrictions, and to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Department of Public Safety, Motor Division.

**IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Trucks and commercial motor vehicles shall be and hereby are prohibited from through travel on Camino Carlos Rael .
2. Trucks and commercial motor vehicles shall be permitted to travel Camino Carlos Rael for the sole purpose of local deliveries or to access businesses or customers located on Camino Carlos Rael.
3. For purposes of this Resolution, the word "truck" shall have the meaning assigned by NMSA 1978, Section 66-1-4.17(N) (1990), but shall apply only to vehicles of gross vehicle weight that exceeds ten (10) tons, regardless of the number of axles and inclusive of any trailer.
4. For purposes of this Resolution, the phrase "commercial motor vehicle" shall have the meaning assigned by NMSA 1978, Section 66-1-4.3(J) but shall apply only to vehicles of gross vehicle weight that exceeds ten (10) tons, regardless of the number of axles and inclusive of any trailer.
5. Staff shall place the appropriate signs describing the restrictions on Camino Carlos and on the adjoining streets whose access is from Camino Carlos Rael. This Resolution shall not become effective until signs are posted.
6. Staff shall transmit a copy of this Resolution to the New Mexico Department of Public Safety, Motor Transportation Division. This Resolution shall not become effective until a copy of the Resolution has been so transmitted.
