Resolution No. 2010 - 25

A Resolution Recognizing and Celebrating February 13 as Love Your River Day.

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe River is a significant natural and cultural landmark in Santa Fe County; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe River is an important natural watercourse that provides critical riparian habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe River provided life sustaining water that made it possible for people to settle here and shaped the development of Santa Fe and the traditional farming communities that depended on its waters; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe River still provides water for domestic use and irrigation for the City of Santa Fe and the traditional farming communities along its banks; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe River is important to maintaining the traditional ways of life of the Pueblos of Tesuque, Cochiti, and Santo Domingo, and the traditional Hispanic communities of Agua Fria, La Cieneguilla, La Cienega, and La Bajada; and

WHEREAS, citizens of Santa Fe enjoyed swimming, fishing, and skating along the Santa Fe River well into the 20th century and still enjoy walking and riding horses along its banks; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe River is significant to the character and sense of place of the Santa Fe area; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County is collaborating with the City of Santa Fe and various government agencies and non-profit organizations to restore the Santa Fe River; and

WHEREAS, in 2001, the Santa Fe City Council established the Adopt the River Program in partnership with the Santa Fe Watershed Association; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County has partnered with the Santa Fe Watershed Association to bring the Adopt the River Program to the Santa Fe River in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Adopt the River program engages the business community, youth, and citizens of Santa Fe in restoring the Santa Fe River to its rightful place as the heart of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Adopt the River program, co-sponsors with Santa Fe County and the City of Santa Fe an annual Love Your River Day to raise awareness about the importance of the Santa Fe River to the community of Santa Fe




