**A RESOLUTION**

**SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF SANTA FE COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN  
SEEKING AUTHORITY TO ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF MAKING REAL PROPERTY IMPROVEMENTS OR PURCHASES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the economic, social and cultural value that higher education brings to City of Santa Fe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners acknowledges the need of higher educational institutions to provide and maintain for their students the facilities and resources necessary to the students' academic endeavors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Board of the Santa Fe Community College has determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Community College to erect, furnish, construct, purchase, remodel or equip buildings and utility facilities and to make other real property improvements or purchases for the benefit of the Community College and its students; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Board of the Santa Fe Community College has called a special election to be held in Santa Fe County, New Mexico, on Tuesday, August 3, 2010, at which time Santa Fe Community College shall submit the following question to the registered qualified electors of the Santa Fe Community College District:

1 "Shall Santa Fe Community College District issue up to \$35,000,000 in  
2 general obligation bonds, in one series or more, payable from general (ad  
3 valorem) property taxes for the purposes of erecting and furnishing,  
4 constructing, purchasing, remodeling and equipping buildings and utility  
5 facilities and making other real property improvements or for purchasing  
6 grounds for projects, including, among others, one or more of the following: a  
7 higher learning center or downtown campus, the shell space for theatre arts,  
8 lighting efficiency retrofit, renewable electricity generation and infrastructure  
9 renewal and information technology upgrades?"; and


10 **WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners desires to express its support of  
11 the efforts of the Governing Board of the Santa Fe Community College to seek voters  
12 approval for this proposition;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY**  
14 **COMMISSIONERS** that Santa Fe County supports the efforts of Santa Fe Community  
15 College to ask the registered qualified electors of the Santa Fe Community College District to  
16 answer in the affirmative the question submitted to them at the August 3, 2010 special  
17 election.
