## *Ordinance No. 1995-8*

---

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DECLARING  
THE VILLAGE OF AGUA FRIA  
TO BE A TRADITIONAL HISTORIC COMMUNITY**

---

**WHEREAS**, a petition has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners requesting the designation of the area heretofore known as the Village of Agua Fria as a traditional historic community; and

**WHEREAS**, the petition has been referred to the County Clerk for review and consideration for sufficiency; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Clerk has reviewed the petition and reported that it is sufficient pursuant to Chapter 211, Laws of New Mexico 1995; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has certified the petition as valid.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe hereby finds that:

1. The area identified on the attached map as the Village of Agua Fria:
  - a. is an unincorporated area of Santa Fe County;
  - b. is an identifiable village, community, neighborhood or district that is documented as being in existence for more than one hundred years; and
  - c. includes structures or landmarks associated with the identity of the area traditionally known as the Village of Agua Fria, and is an area with a distinctive character or traditional quality that can be distinguished from surrounding areas or new developments in the vicinity.

WHEREFORE, as of the effective date of this Ordinance, the area identified on the attached map as the Village of Agua Fria, is declared a traditional historic community under state law.
