**Section Four. Review.**

A. As appropriate, during the period when this Ordinance is effective, Santa Fe County staff shall continually analyze and make recommendations concerning the continuing need for the moratorium created in this Ordinance, with respect to each of the following:

1. New information received by Staff concerning the ability of EAWSD to deliver sufficient water to meet the needs of existing and committed future users;

2. New information received or developed by Staff concerning the aquifer characteristics within the geographic area within which this Ordinance is effective, but Santa Fe County staff are not required to conduct independent investigations to develop such information; and

3. Any information provided by EAWSD that tends to establish that EAWSD meets or exceeds the standards set forth in Article VII, §§ 6.3 and 6.4.4 of the Santa Fe County Land Development Code, Ordinance No. 1996-10 (as amended).

**Section Five. Effective Date, Automatic Repeal.** This Ordinance shall become effective pursuant to NMSA 1978, § 4-37-9 (1997), and shall remain in effect for six months unless repealed by separate action of the Board of County Commissioners, and shall be repealed without further action of the Board of County Commissioners six months following its effective date.
