PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY; EFFECTIVE DATE

Section 1.1 PURPOSE: The purpose of this Ordinance is to

11

increase the size of the County Commission of Santa Fe County

12

from three to five members and to divide the County into five

13

county commission districts in order to provide better

14

representation of the citizenry in the conduct of County

15

business.

Section 1.2 AUTHORITY: This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to

18

Article X, Section 7(C) of the Constitution of the State of

19

New Mexico, as amended.

Section 1.3 EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be effective

22

thirty days after its adoption by the Board of County

23

Commissioners as provided by law. This Ordinance may not be

24

adopted except by unanimous vote.

Section 2.1 NUMBER: As of the first day of January, 1991, the County shall be divided by precinct into five compact, contiguous, and substantially equally populated county commission districts as follows:

Section 2.2 [REDACTED] County commission district ONE shall comprise the following precincts: 1, 2, 3, 11, 12, 13, 21, 22, 31, 32, 33, 41, 42, 52, 61, 90, 91, and 92.

Section 2.3 [REDACTED] County commission district TWO shall comprise the following precincts: 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 111, 112, 113, 114, 115, 121, 122, 123, 124, 131, 132, 133, 143, 144, 145, 161, 162, and 175.

Section 2.4 [REDACTED] County commission district THREE shall comprise the following precincts: 60, 62, 63, 64, 174, 176, 181, 182, 192, 201, and 203.

Section 2.5 [REDACTED] County commission district FOUR shall comprise the following precincts: 51, 53, 54, 55, 71, 72, 73, 74, 93, 141, 142, 151, 152, 153, 154, 155, 158, 163, 164, 165, and 167.


