The County of Santa Fe Public Works Department is requesting bids for *On-Call Road Construction and Maintenance Services* for miscellaneous road construction projects throughout Santa Fe County. Pursuant to Section 13-1-154 NMSA 1978, the award for these services will be a multiple source award. Bids may be held for ninety (90) days subject to action by the County. The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids in part or in whole. By submitting a bid for the requested materials and/or services each bidder is certifying that their bid is in compliance with regulations and requirements stated within the Invitation for Bid package. The County of Santa Fe reserves the right to reject any and all bids in part or whole. A completed bid package shall be submitted in a sealed envelope indicating the bid title and number along with the bidding firm's name and address clearly marked on the outside of the container. Bids are due no later than **Friday, March 29, 2013 at 2:00 PM (MDT) and delivered to office of the Procurement Manager, Santa Fe County, 142 W. Palace (Second Floor), Santa Fe, New Mexico.**

**Pre-Bid Conference be held on Friday, March 15, 2013 at 10:00 AM (MDT)** at the Public Works Facility Conference Room located at Public Works Facility at 424 West NM 599 Frontage Road Access. The attendance to the Pre-Bid Conference is not Mandatory, but is strongly recommended for information pertaining to the General Contractor's Qualification Statement.

**EQUAL OPPORTUNITY EMPLOYMENT:** All qualified bidders will receive consideration of contract(s) without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, age, physical and mental handicap, serious mental condition, disability, spousal affiliation, sexual orientation or gender identity.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS

Santa Fe County Public Works Department is responsible for maintenance of road infrastructure through Santa Fe County. It is the intent of the County to establish a multi-award price agreement for the concrete and road construction services, which may be required pursuant to Section 13-1-154 NMSA 1978. Unit pricing shall be established for each category of construction and quantities shall be determined on a per project basis. Bids are requested by Santa Fe County for On Call Road and Maintenance Services.

1. **LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION OF WORK:** The work under this contract is located within the Santa Fe County, New Mexico. The work consists of furnishing all equipment, labor and materials as specified in the various County road construction projects.

The bids shall be in the form of unit pricing as per items listed in the bid form. Unit pricing shall be established for each category of construction and quantities shall be determined on a per project basis. The unit prices shall include all permits, fees, tie-in fees for all utilities, overhead and profit and incidental costs in the bid amounts.

All applicable laws and ordinances and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over the project shall apply to the contractor and all agreements between the contractor and the County.

2. **TIME AND PLACE OF RECEIVING AND OPENING BIDS:** This information will be found in the "Advertisement for Bids" form attached hereto. A bid received after the specified time will not be considered and will be returned to the bidder unopened.
3. **SPECIFICATIONS:** The construction of these project(s) will be in accordance with the NEW MEXICO STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION 1987 EDITION (NMSSPWC) and the NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAY AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION 2007 EDITION.
4. **ROAD MAINTENANCE:** Road maintenance shall not be performed on a private road and shall only be performed on a County-maintained road that has been placed on the list submitted to the State of New Mexico pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 67-3-28.3 (1987). Road maintenance work, including routine and priority maintenance, must be identified equitably in each Commission District, unless there is no need for a project in a particular district.
5. **DEFINED TERMS:** Unless otherwise indicated, terms used in these Instructions for Bidders have the meanings assigned to them in Section 101 of the NMDOT Standard Specifications for Highway and Bridge Construction, 2007 Edition, as modified.
6. **EXAMINATION OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS AND SITE:** Before submitting its bid, each bidder shall (a) examine the bidding documents thoroughly, (b) familiarize itself with federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations affecting

performance of the work; and (c) carefully correlate their observations with the requirements of the contract documents. The submission of a Bid constitutes representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this section and that the contract documents are sufficient in scope to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance of the work.

7. **INTERPRETATIONS:** All questions about the meaning or intent of the contract documents shall be submitted to the Procurement Manager in writing. Replies will be issued by Addenda mailed or delivered to all parties recorded by the County, as having received the bidding documents at least five (5) days before the scheduled bid opening date. Questions received less than seven (7) days prior to the date for opening of bids will not be answered. Only questions answered by formal written Addenda will be binding. Oral and other interpretations or clarifications will be without legal effect.
8. **CONTRACT TIME:** The work and contract time shall be defined in the scope of work for each respective road project and as negotiated with the contractor.
9. **PREFERENCE IN PROCUREMENT BY SANTA FE COUNTY:**

A. *New Mexico In-state Preference.*

To receive a resident business preference pursuant to Section 13-1-21 NMSA 1978 or a resident contractor preference pursuant to Section 13-40-2 NMSA 1978, a business or contractor shall submit with its bid or proposal a copy of a valid resident business certificate or valid resident contractor certificate issued by the NM Department of Taxation and Revenue.

If an Offeror or Bidder submits with its proposal or bid a copy of a valid and current in-state resident business/contractor certificate, 5% of the total weight of all evaluation factors used in the evaluation of proposals may be awarded or added to the Offerors score and in the event of a Bidder, the bid will be 5% lower than the bid actually submitted.

Certification by the NM Department of Taxation and Revenue for the resident business or resident contractor takes into consideration such activities as the business or contractor's payment of property taxes or rent in the state.

**OR**

B. *New Mexico Resident Veteran Preference.*

New Mexico law, Section 13-1-22 NMSA 1978, provides a preference in the award of a public works contract for a "**resident veteran business**". Certification by the department of taxation and revenue for the resident veteran business requires the Offeror to provide evidence of annual revenue and other evidence of veteran status.

An Offeror or Bidder who wants the veteran business preference to be applied to its proposal is required to submit with its proposal the certification from the department of taxation and revenue and the sworn affidavit attached hereto as Appendix E.

If an Offeror or Bidder submits with its proposal a copy of a valid and current veteran resident business certificate, 10%, 8% or 7% of the total weight of all the evaluation factors used in the evaluation of proposals may be awarded or added to the Offerors score, depending on the business' annual revenue or 10%, 8% or 7% of the bid will be lower than the bid actually submitted.

**The resident business preference is not cumulative with the resident veteran business preference.**

10. **SUBCONTRACTORS, SUPPLIERS AND OTHERS:**

- A. The Contractor, in the bid documents, must identify in writing to the County those portions of the work that it proposes to subcontract and after the Notice of Award, may only subcontract other portions of the work with the County's written consent.
- B. Any subcontractor who will be providing more than \$5,000.00 for any service must be listed on the Subcontract Listing.
- C. A subcontractor that submits a bid valued at more than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for a County project is subject to the Public Works Minimum Wage Act (13-4-10 NMSA 1978). The registration number shall be provided in the bid submitted by the Contractor in the space provided for subcontracts with work proposed. After the bid opening, the registration numbers will be verified by the County and the bid will be determined to be non-responsive and disqualified if the registration number(s) appear to be invalid and the subcontractor does not provide proof of the required registration for itself or its subcontractors for work proposed over the sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000).
- D. The Contractor will not be required to employ any other subcontractor, other person or organization against whom it has reasonable objection.
- E. The NM Public Works Minimum Wage Act requires all tiers of subcontractors to submit certified weekly payroll records to the general contract and the County bi-weekly. The Contractor shall require all tiers of contractors to submit certified weekly payroll records to the Contractor and the County Project Manager for this project. The certified weekly payroll records shall be submitted to the Contractor and Mr. Diego Gomez, Santa Fe County Public Works Department, Road Division, P.O. Box 276, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-0276.

11. **PERMITS:** It is the responsibility of the Contractor and each Subcontractor to obtain required permits and inspections in accordance with Santa Fe County and State of New Mexico Construction Industries Division or any other entity that may have jurisdiction over the construction.

12. **BID SECURITY:** Bid security in the amount of \$5,000 shall accompany the bid proposal and must be in the form of a certified or bank cashier's check made payable to Santa Fe County or the Bidder or a bid bond issued by a surety licensed to conduct business in the State of New Mexico, or other supplies in a form satisfactory to the County. The bid security of the successful bidder shall be retained until it has executed the price agreement and furnished the required bid security, whereupon it will be returned. If the successful bidder fails to execute and deliver the price agreement and furnish the required bid security within ten (10) days of the Notice of Award, the County may annul the Notice of Award and the bid security of that bidder will be forfeited.
13. **WAGE RATES:** The Public Works Minimum Wage Act, NMSA 1978, §§ 13-4-10 through 13-4-17, applies to any contract between the County and a contractor in excess of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for construction, alteration, demolition, or repair, or any combination of these, including painting and decorating, of public buildings or public works. The minimum wage rate determination issued by the Office of the Labor Commissioner for this Project is enclosed herewith or will be issued via addendum.

It shall be the successful Bidder's responsibility to inform itself thoroughly of all state, federal and local laws and statutes pertaining to the employment of labor, the freedom of organization and the conditions of employment and shall strictly adhere to such laws and regulations as are applicable. There shall be no discrimination because of race, creed, color, national origin or legal political affiliation in the employment of persons qualified by training and experience for work under this contract.

If the Bidder's base bid is in excess of \$60,000, the bidder shall ensure that, in submitting their Bid, the minimum wage rate determination for this project (if any) has been utilized in preparing its Bid.

14. **BID FORM:**
- A. The Bid Form is included in the bidding documents; additional copies may be obtained from the Santa Fe County Purchasing Division.
  - B. Bid Forms must be completed in either ink or typewritten. The bid price of each item on the form must be stated in numerals and written words; in case of an error in extensions in the unit price schedule the unit price shown in written words shall govern.
  - C. Bids by corporations must be executed in the corporate name by the president or a vice president (or other corporate officer accompanied by evidence of authority to sign) and the corporate seal shall be affixed and attested by the secretary or an assistant secretary. The corporate address and state of incorporation shall be shown below the signature.
  - D. Bids by partnerships must be executed in the partnership name and signed by a partner, the partner's title must appear under the signature and the official address of the partnership must be shown below the signature.
  - E. All names must be typed or printed below the signature.
  - F. The bid shall contain an acknowledgment of receipt of all Addenda (the numbers of which shall be filled in on the Bid Form).

15. **QUALIFICATION OF BIDS:** All bidders and subcontractors must have a valid New Mexico Contractor's License appropriate to the work herein specified; be actively registered with the NM Workforce Solution on the bid due date; and submitted a completed and notarized General Contractor's Statement of Qualification (Appendix G).
16. **SUBMISSION OF BIDS:** Bids shall be submitted at the time and place indicated in the Advertisement for Bids and shall be enclosed in an opaque sealed envelope, marked with the project title, name and address of the bidder, N.M. License Number, and accompanied by the list of subcontractors and other required documents. All blanks must be filled in.

Conditional bids will not be considered. The envelope shall be addressed to:

17. **MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS:** Bids may be modified or withdrawn by an appropriate document duly executed and delivered to the place where bids are to be submitted at any time prior to the opening of bids.
18. **BID OPENING PROCEDURE:** The person or persons opening the bids shall review the bids for the following:
- A. Bid Proposal – Include name of Bidder, type or organization, contractor's license number and NM Workforce Solutions registration number and all required signatures
  - B. Bid Form – Include acknowledgement of all addenda (if applicable), Bidder's name, title, address, telephone number, contractor's license number, and Federal Identification Number and all required signatures
  - C. Non-Collusion Affidavit of Prime Bidder – Completed, signed, and notarized
  - D. Certification of Non-segregated Facilities – Completed, signed, and notarized
  - E. Certification of Bidder Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity - Completed and signed
  - F. Subcontractor Listing – Completed with trade, name of subcontractor, telephone number, license number, and NM Department of Workplace Solutions number for each subcontractor's services over the \$5,000 threshold
  - G. Bid Sheet – Include best prices offered for unit price and extension amount. Provide a clearly written total amount written in words
  - H. Bid Bond (with Power of Attorney from Surety Company)
  - I. Campaign Contribution Form (Completed and signed)
  - J. General Contractor's Statement of Qualification

**IF ANY OF THESE REQUIREMENTS HAVE NOT BEEN MET, THE BID MAY BE DISQUALIFIED AND CONSIDERED A NON-RESPONSIVE BID. ANY DISQUALIFIED BIDS WILL NOT BE READ.**

19. **BIDS TO REMAIN OPEN:** All bids shall remain open for ninety (90) days after the day of the bid opening.
20. **SUBSTITUTIONS:** The bid shall not be qualified by the proposal of substitutions for specified materials or equipment.
21. **AWARD OF CONTRACT:**
  - A. The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids and waive any and all informalities or technicalities and the right to disregard all nonconforming or conditional bids or counter proposals.
  - B. If a contract is to be awarded, it will be multi-award to the lowest responsible bidder(s) whose General Contractor's Statement of Qualifications has been evaluated and it indicates to the County that the award will be in the best interest of the projects and the County and based upon the culmination of the bid items.
  - C. If the lowest responsible bidder has otherwise qualified, the lowest bidder may negotiate with the County for a lower bid if the lowest bid is within ten percent over budgeted project funds in order to prevent all bids from being rejected. No change in the original scope of the terms or terms and conditions will be allowed. Terms and conditions refer to the contract requirements, warranties, and bonds. Negotiation may be permitted with product, materials, and equipment alternatives as determined to be in the best interest of the County.
  - D. Alternates may only be considered after determination of low base bid. Alternates may be accepted and awarded in any order based upon available budget.
22. **PREFERENCES IN EQUIPMENT OR MATERIAL:** In the construction of these project(s), the County has no preference for any process, type of equipment, or kind of material, but will consider all processes, types of equipment or kinds of material offered on a usual competitive basis if they are in fact equal to that specified and will accomplish the purpose intended. The County reserves the right to be the sole judge as to whether or not a different process, type of equipment or kind of material offered is in fact equal to that specified.
23. **LICENSE OR ROYALTY FEES:** Licenses and/or royalty fees for products or for processes must be paid for directly by the contractor.
24. **ADDENDUM:** Each addendum shall be made a part of the contract documents to the same extent as though contained in the original documents and itemized listing thereof. Each bidder shall acknowledge receipt of each addendum in the space provided on the bid proposal form.
25. **COLLUSION:** No Bidder shall be interested in more than one bid. Collusion among Bidders or the submission of more than one bid under different names by any firms or individual shall be cause for rejection of all bids in question without consideration.

26. **QUANTITIES:** The quantities set forth in the bid proposal are estimated quantities on which bids will be compared and which will be the basis for award of contract. Payment will be made for the work actually performed.
27. **POWER OF ATTORNEY:** Attorneys in fact who sign bonds must attach certified effective copies of their Power of Attorney to all bonds.
28. **PROTEST PROCEDURE:** Any bidder, offeror, or contractor who is aggrieved in connection with the procurement may protest to the County Purchasing Director as set forth in Resolution No. 2006-60 by the Board of County Commissioners. The complete procedures and requirements regarding protests and resolution of protests are available from the Purchasing Office upon request.

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29. **CONSIDERATION OF BIDS:** Receipt, Opening and Recording. Bids received on time will be opened publicly and will be read aloud, and an abstract of the amounts of the Base Bids and Alternates or Bid Items, if any, will be made available to the Bidders. Each Bid shall be open to public inspection.
30. **COMPETITIVE SEALED BIDS:** Contracts solicited by competitive sealed bids shall require that the bid amount exclude applicable New Mexico Gross Receipts Taxes or applicable local option taxes, but that the County shall be required to pay the applicable taxes, including any increase in the applicable tax which becomes effective after the date the contract is entered into. The applicable Gross Receipts Tax shall be computed and shown as a separate amount on the Bid Proposal and on each request for payment made under the contract.
31. **NOTICE OF AWARD:** A written Notice of Award shall be issued by the County after review and approval of the Bid and related documents with reasonable promptness.
32. **IDENTICAL BIDS:** When two or more of the Bids submitted are identical in price and are the low Bid, the County Purchasing Manager or the County may:
- A. Award pursuant to the multiple source award provisions of the Procurement Code;
  - B. Award to a resident business if the identical low Bids are submitted by a resident business and a nonresident business;
  - C. Award by lottery to one of the identical low Bidders;
  - D. Reject all Bids and resolicit Bids or proposals for the required services, construction, or items of tangible personal property.
33. **CANCELLATION OF AWARD:** When in the best interest of the public, the County may cancel the award of any contract at any time before the execution of said contract by all parties without any liability against the County.

34. **NOTICE TO PROCEED:** The County will issue a written Notice to Proceed and a purchase order to the Contractor stipulating the date from which Contract time will be charged and the date Contract Time is to expire, subject to valid modifications of the Contract authorized by Change Order.
35. **FAILURE TO EXECUTE CONTRACT:** Failure to return the signed Contract with acceptable Contract Bonds and Certificate of Insurance within ten (10) calendar days after the date of the Notice of Award shall be just cause for the cancellation of the award. The award may then be made to the next lowest responsible Bidder, or the work may be re-advertised and constructed under contract or otherwise, as the County may decide.
36. **CONTRACTOR'S QUALIFICATION STATEMENT:** Bidder to whom award of a Contract is under consideration shall complete the General Contractor's Statement of Qualification information and data to prove that their financial resources, production or service facilities, personnel, and service reputation and experience are adequate to make satisfactory delivery of the services, construction, or items of personal property described in the Bidding. (Appendix G)
37. **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:** At a minimum upon execution of the Agreement between the County and the Contractor, the Contractor shall furnish to the County, Certificates of Insurance for the following insurance coverage to be in effect throughout the project:
- A. Workmen's Compensation: Statutory Limits
  - B. Public Liability: \$1,050,000.00 per occurrence
  - C. Property Damage: \$1,050,000.00 per occurrence

Contractor shall carry insurance to protect itself and Santa Fe County from and against all claims, demands, actions, judgments, costs, expenses and liabilities which may arise or result directly or indirectly from or by reasons of loss, injury or damage related to the Project. Santa Fe County shall be named as an additional insured to this policy. The Contractor shall file with Santa Fe County current certificates evidencing public liability insurance with limits as provided in the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, NMSA 1978, Section 41-4-1, et seq, and as amended from time-to-time. The contractor shall also carry such insurance as it deems necessary to protect it from all claims under any workmen's compensation law in effect that may be applicable to the Contractor. All insurance required by this Agreement shall be kept and remain in full force and effect for the entire life of this Agreement.

The insurance coverage shall include worker's compensation, employers liability, comprehensive general liability (Premises-Operations, independent contractors, products and completed operations, broad form property damage, contractual liability, explosion and collapse hazard, underground Hazard, personal injury), comprehensive automobile liability (owned and hired), excess liability (umbrella form), and all-risk builder's risk.

38. **BOND REQUIREMENTS – PERFORMANCE AND LABOR AND MATERIAL.** If awarded the contract, a bidder shall furnish bonds covering the faithful performance of

the contract and payment of all obligations arising thereunder. The amount of the bonds, performance and labor and material shall each be equal to 100% of the specific project sum for each project over \$25,000.00. Bonds shall be issued by a surety authorized to conduct business in the State of New Mexico and who is approved in federal circular 570 as published by the U.S. Treasury Department. The cost of the bonds shall be included at the time of work.

39. **WARRANTY:** The Contractor shall furnish a written warranty of workmanship for a period of one (1) year following the Completion Date.
40. **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:** Contractor agrees that the liquidated damages will be determined, on a per project basis, unless otherwise specified in the contract. Determination will be made according to Section 108.8 Liquidated Damages (pg 53) of the New Mexico Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway and Bridge Construction, 2007 Edition.
41. **SUBCONTRACTOR PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND.** A subcontractor whose work to be performed on a public works building project is one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) or more shall submit a performance and payment bond in the amount of the work they are to perform on the project. These bonds will be submitted within the stated (10) calendar days after the date of the Notice to Award.
42. **NOTICE:** The Procurement Code, Sections 13-1-28 through 13-1-199 NMSA 1978, imposes civil and misdemeanor criminal penalties for its violation. In addition, the New Mexico criminal statutes impose felony penalties for bribes, gratuities, and kick backs.
43. **NUMBER SUFFICIENT APPROPRIATION:** Any contract awarded as a result of this IFB process may be terminated if sufficient appropriations or authorizations do not exist. Such termination will be effected by sending written notice to the contractor. The County's decision as to whether sufficient appropriations and authorizations are available will be accepted by the contractor as final.
44. **NUMBER OF BIDS ACCEPTED.** Bidders shall submit only one (1) bid in response to this IFB.

Wages rates will be requested for each job over the \$60,000.00 threshold and will be the responsibility of Santa Fe County.

## **8. PAYROLL**

All Contractors and subcontractors shall submit one (1) certified copy of the project weekly payroll to the Project Manager, Santa Fe County Public Works Department, Road Construction Division, P.O. Box 276, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0276, and one (1) copy also certified directly to the New Mexico State Labor Commission - Public Works Division, Aspen Building, 1596 Pacheco Street, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501, not later than five (5) working days after the close of each payroll period. The prime contractor shall be responsible for the submission of copies of payrolls of all sub-contractors.

## **9. APPRENTICES**

Before using apprentices on this project, the Contractor shall present to the Contracting Officer written evidence of registration of such employees with the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training, Western Bank Building (Room 1414), 505 Marquette Avenue, N.W., Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102, Telephone 245-2142. If the apprentice is not registered in a bona fide apprenticeship program as mentioned above, the journeyman's wage rate for that particular classification in which he/she is working is applicable.

## **10. CONTRACT TIME**

The term of this agreement shall be two (2) years from date of award with the option to extend for an additional period of two (2) years on a year-by-year basis, by mutual agreement of all parties and approval of the Santa Fe County at the same terms and conditions. This agreement shall not exceed four (4) years.

## **11. CONTRACT COMPLETION DATE**

The day count for all work will be assigned by the Project Manager on a task-by-task basis. If the day count is not met the Contractor shall be assessed liquidated damages for each consecutive Calendar Day in excess of the completion date in accordance with Section 108.8, Liquidated Damages, in the Standard Specifications.

**12. LARGE ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

Santa Fe County reserves the right to go out for bid for large construction projects. All awarded contractors will be notified prior to solicitation.

The bidder shall show the products of the respective unit bid prices and quantities and shall also show the total amount of his bid in the space provided in the proposal form. Said total amount bid shall be the total sum obtained by adding the amounts of the individual items.

The bidder is permitted to show the amount(s) for the respective unit bid price(s) written in words and written in numerals to a maximum of two decimal places. Any additional decimal places in excess of two shall be truncated and will not be considered in the processing of the proposal.

Manufacturer's Data: Catalog type literature on the item.

Shop Drawings: Detailed drawings with all dimensions and locations shown.

Samples: The item that will be supplied.

Certifications: Any certifications required by these Specifications or standard specification and/or requirements for that item, to cover raw materials and testing of the final product.

Guarantees: A copy of the guarantee to be given to the Owner on a particular item.

Lab Test Reports: Laboratory test reports required to show that the item meets all specified requirements, or required for the preparation of a design mix or job mix formula.

Field Test Reports: Reports of tests that have been conducted on the item as installed or constructed in the field.
