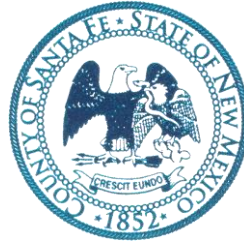

Listed below are clarifications of the IFB and questions received via email concerning the above referenced IFB.

Clarification: **Contract Time is 70 days.**

Question# 1- At the Richards Avenue site is the County requesting the contractors to install the dog legs then hot taps?

Answer# 1- *The sequence of construction shall be conducted such that no water outage is anticipated. Specification 1010- Summary of Work, Section 1.0.D provides the Work Sequence for this site.*

Question# 2- Is the Richards Avenue water system a loop or a one way?

Answer# 2- *Richards Avenue water main is not looped.*

- Question# 3- How will the ordering of the 16” Butterfly Valves affect the project duration?
- Answer# 3- *Project duration may be modified if long-lead time(s) affect the overall project construction schedule and are justified with documented delivery schedule, subject to Owner’s review and acceptance of the schedule.*
- Question# 4- Will the Notice to Proceed allow the contractors to buy the materials?
- Answer# 4- *The Notice to Proceed Date may be modified in consideration of long-lead equipment delivery dates, subject to Owner’s review and acceptance of the schedule.*
- Question# 5- Do these projects have to be done in the order they are listed?
- Answer # 5- *The order may be modified to coordinate with delivery of long lead items subject to Owner’s review and acceptance of the schedule..*
- Question# 6- Can you please provide the specs on the hatch?
- Answer # 6- *Specification 08659-Vault Access Door provides the details required on the vault hatch.*
- Question# 7- How far off the road is the master meter at the Campo Conejos location?
- Answer # 7- *As shown in Drawing C-02, the vault meter is approximately 60 feet south, from the south edge of pavement of Rabbit Road.*
- Question #8- The tapping saddles on the main show a FL-FL gate valve with a mega-flange adaptor. Can we substitute a FlxMJ Gate valve with mega-lug restraint in lieu of using the mega-flange?
- Answer #8- *Yes, the proposed substitution of a FL-FL gate valve with a mega-flange adaptor to a FlxMJ Gate valve with a mega-lug restraint is acceptable.*
- Question #9- Will Domestic Material be required for this project?
- Answer #9- *No, materials do not have to be domestic.*

- Question #10- What Entity or Agency is Funding this project?*
- Answer #10- Santa Fe County Utilities*

- Question #11- Spec 15050, 2.07 & 3.03, F: Spec 1550, 3.03, F states “Install on buried and submerged piping” Where are the “Caps” (Spec 15050, 2.07) required? Are they required in the Vaults?*
- Answer #11- Threaded Caps are required in all conditions. From 15050.2.07, “Caps shall be suitable to use in exposed, buried, and submerged service conditions”. They are required for all exposed nuts and bolt threads on pipeline fittings in the vaults.*

- Question #12- Will Electronic Marking Disks per NMAPWA 801.9.10 be required?*
- Answer #12- Yes, they will be required for this project.*

- Question #13- Plan Sheet D-02, Detail 3 shows a Drain Valve Detail. Where is this to be installed?*
- Answer #13- Detail 3 in Sheet D-02 is not required to be installed.*

- Question #14- Spec 09961 Fusion Bonded Epoxy Lining and Coatings, 1.01, A: Specification implies that this section requires “valves, flexible pipe couplings, slide gates, and steel pipe” to have Fusion Bonded Epoxy and Coating. Is that correct? Will the 6” Vent Pipe and the 16” Buried Tie-In at Existing CCP require FBE?*
- Answer #14- The 6” Vent Pipe shall be SCH. 40 galvanized steel and does not require FBE. The 16” Buried, Tie-In fitting will be required to be FBE coated. Stainless Steel, in lieu of FBE Coated Steel, would be acceptable as well.*

Please add this Addendum #1 to the original bid documents and refer to bid documents, hereto as such. This and all subsequent addenda will become part of any resulting contract documents and have effects as if original issued. All other unaffected sections will have their original interpretation and remain in full force and effect.
