**Agreement Accepting Restricted Gift
Between Santa Fe County and
The St. Vincent Hospital Foundation**

This Agreement Accepting Restricted Gift ("Agreement") is entered into this 13 day of July, 2012 by and between the St. Vincent Hospital Foundation, a duly formed 501(c)(3) organization, 455 St. Michael's Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505, the CHRISTUS St. Vincent Regional Medical Center, a private not-for-profit hospital, 455 St. Michael's Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505, and Santa Fe County, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-0276, a political subdivision of the State of New Mexico (hereinafter the "County").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, heart disease is the number one killer in the United States. Over 1.1 million people will suffer a heart attack this year and unfortunately over half of those people will not survive. In addition to the high mortality rate, many other people will sustain permanent heart muscle damage and be forced to lead a compromised lifestyle;

WHEREAS, the most serious form of heart attack an ST-segment elevation myocardial infarction or "STEMI" is due to a complete blockage of a coronary artery which directly supplies blood to the heart muscle. The sooner the blood supply can be restored by opening the blocked artery, the more likely the individual is to survive;

WHEREAS, in the treatment of a STEMI heart attack time is of the essence and seconds and minutes can mean the difference between life and death;

WHEREAS, the St. Vincent Hospital d/b/a CHRISTUS St. Vincent Regional Medical Center in Santa Fe, New Mexico, has an interventional cardiologist and cardiac catheterization team on duty 24 hours a day 7 days a week to provide life saving emergency angioplasty to open blocked arteries for those suffering from a STEMI heart attack;

WHEREAS, the St. Vincent Hospital Foundation is the supporting fund-raising organization for the CHRISTUS St. Vincent Regional Medical Center;

WHEREAS, the St. Vincent Hospital Foundation and the CHRISTUS St. Vincent Regional Medical Center are independent entities each with its own governing board;

WHEREAS, the County's Fire Department's EMS currently responds to and cares for individuals who suffer from heart attacks and chest pain. EMS currently stabilizes a patient and then transports the patient to the CHRISTUS St. Vincent Emergency Center. Once transported to the Emergency Center an electrocardiogram (ECG) is performed to determine whether the patient is actually suffering from a STEMI heart attack. If the heart attack is confirmed by performance of an ECG to be a STEMI, the Emergency Center contacts the Medical Center's Cardiac Cath Lab to begin treatment of the patient;

WHEREAS, the parties have determined a more efficient method to significantly decrease the time involved in responding to and treating STEMI heart attacks on an emergency basis;

WHEREAS, an ECG can be performed at the location where the County's EMS responds to an emergency call, be that in a patient's home or elsewhere or during the EMS' transport of the patient to the Emergency Center.

WHEREAS, CHRISTUS St. Vincent Regional Medical Center and its supporting organization St. Vincent Hospital Foundation are willing to donate equipment to the County so that an ECG can be immediately transmitted to the Medical Center's Cardiac Cath Lab and the Emergency Center can prepare for a patient's arrival in the hope of saving precious time and lives.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual obligations herein, the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

1. The St. Vincent Hospital Foundation will purchase and donate the following equipment to the County:

- Seventeen (17) 21996-000086 Multi-Tech 3G Gateway modems-- Verizon with warranty
- Seventeen (17) 5-year Verizon LifeNet transmission subscriptions

2. This donation is given without payment of any kind from the County to the CHRISTUS St. Vincent Regional Medical Center or the St. Vincent Hospital Foundation and expressly on the condition that the County obtains a subscription that is compatible with the Emergency Center's 12 Lead Telemetry System.


- Multi-Tech Gateway Data Plan - Verizon is the transmission system identified as compatible with the CHRISTUS St. Vincent Regional Medical Center's 12 Lead Telemetry System.

3. If all or part of this donated equipment cannot at some time in the future be used fully or practically applied to the above purpose or if the purpose cannot be achieved because of a future change in law or unforeseeable circumstances, the equipment may be used for any related purpose which will most early accomplish the purpose of this Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this Agreement as of the date first written above and by its execution of this Agreement the County ratifies the acceptance of the donation of equipment from CHRISTUS St. Vincent Regional Medical Center and the St. Vincent Hospital Foundation.






