

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO
SERVICE AGREEMENT NO. 2015-0187-CORR/BT**

This **FIRST AMENDMENT** ("First Amendment") is effective as of the last date signed by a party ("First Amendment Effective Date") and amends and clarifies that certain Service Agreement to Provide Inmate Telephone Service ("Agreement No. 2015-0187-CORR/BT") by and between Santa Fe County ("Customer") and Securus Technologies, Inc. ("Contractor"), dated February 2, 2015.

WHEREAS, Customer desires and Contractor agrees to amend Agreement No. 2015-0187-CORR/BT to clarify that Contractor's services with regard to Prepaid Services/ Phone Cards will include the sale of Prepaid Calling Cards to the Customer's commissary operator (Keefe Commissary Services) who provides commissary services in accordance with Agreement No. 2015-0063-CORR/IC between Customer and Keefe Commissary Services.

WHEREAS, with this First Amendment, Customer authorizes Contractor to work directly with the Customer's commissary operator to sell Prepaid Calling Cards to the commissary operator who, pursuant to Agreement 2015-0063-CORR/IC, will make Prepaid Calling Cards available for purchase by inmates and residents of the Santa Fe County Adult Detention Facility ("ADF") and the Youth Development Program ("YDP").

NOW THEREFORE, as of the First Amendment Effective Date and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. **TERM**. This First Amendment shall commence on the First Amendment Effective Date and shall remain in effect throughout the term of Agreement No. 2015-0187-CORR/BT.
2. **PREPAID SERVICES/ PHONE CARDS**. The following provisions will be added to Section D of Agreement No. 2015-0187-CORR/BT.
 - The County authorizes Contractor to work directly with the County's current commissary operator to sell Prepaid Calling Cards to the commissary operator who will make such cards available for purchase by ADF inmates and YDP residents pursuant to the terms and conditions of Agreement No. 2015-0063-CORR/IC.
 - Contractor is neither responsible nor liable for any fees or other compensation charged to the inmates and residents by the Customer's commissary operator and Contractor shall not interfere with nor be responsible for any compensation agreement entered into between the Customer and Customer's commissary operator.
 - Each Prepaid Calling Card will be valid for not more than six (6) months from the date it is first used. The Prepaid Calling Cards are not returnable or refundable; all sales to the Customer's commissary operator are final. The Prepaid Calling Cards are subject to applicable local, state, and federal taxes plus any applicable per call surcharge fee on non-local calls.
 - Customer shall provide *written notice* of any change in the identity of the Customer's commissary operator, or any change or amendment to Agreement No. 2015-0063-CORR/IC that may affect Agreement No. 2015-0187-CORR/BT between Contractor and


Customer. Contractor will be deemed to have notice of such change or amendment on the date the Contractor receives the notice.

3. All terms and conditions of Agreement No. 2015-0187-CORR/BT between Contractor and Customer which are not amended by this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.







As you know, the County Corrections Department entered into a contract with a new Commissary Vendor for Inmate Commissary items. The new vendor is Keefe Commissary Services. As part of Keefe's scope of work one of the items that they are to provide are calling cards for Inmates. SECURUS provides the telephone services for the inmates at both ADF and YDP Facilities and as part of their services they manage and sell these calling cards to the Commissary Vendor who in turn sells them to the inmates. This amendment authorizes SECURUS to sell the calling cards to Keefe Commissary Services.
