PRIMARY ELECTION PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to the Primary Election Law, NMSA 1978, Sections 1-8-10 to -52 (1969, as amended through 2015), and the Presidential Primary Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 1-15A-1 to -11 (1977, as amended through 2011), I, Geraldine Salazar, Santa Fe County Clerk, State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby issue the following proclamation:

That a Primary Election is called to be held throughout the County of Santa Fe, State of New Mexico and precinct thereof on June 7, 2016;

That a Primary Election shall be applicable to the following political parties: the Democratic Party and the Republican Party; and

That the Primary Election shall be for the purpose of permitting the Democratic Party and the Republican Party to nominate candidates for the following offices:

FEDERAL OFFICES

State, one justice of the Supreme Court, and one judge of the Court of Appeals shall be filed with the Secretary of State on Tuesday, February 2, 2016, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

UNITED STATES PRESIDENT **FOUR-YEAR TERM**

Declarations of candidacy and nominating petitions for state representatives and state senators in multi-county legislative districts, district judges, district attorneys, public regulation commissioners, and public education commissioners shall be filed with the Secretary of State on Tuesday, March 8, 2016, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

TWO UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVES

DISTRICT 1: Santa Fe county precincts 15, 73, and 84 **TWO-YEAR TERM**

DISTRICT 3: Santa Fe county precincts 1 through 14, 16 through 72, 74 through 83, and 85 through 90 **TWO-YEAR TERM**

Declarations of candidacy and nominating petitions for state representatives and state senators in legislative districts wholly within Santa Fe county or composed of only one county shall be filed with the respective county clerk on Tuesday, March 8, 2016, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Declarations of candidacy and filing fees or, in lieu thereof, pauper statements for all other elective county offices shall be filed with the respective county clerk on Tuesday, March 8, 2016, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Declarations of candidacy and nominating petitions for candidates who seek, but fail to receive pre-primary convention designation for a statewide office or the office of United States representative shall be filed with the Secretary of State either ten days following the date of the pre-primary convention or on Tuesday, March 8, 2016, whichever is later, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

DISTRICT 3: Santa Fe county precincts 1 through 11, 13, 14, 16, 17, 20 through 71, 74 through 83, and 86 through 90. **FOUR-YEAR TERM**

Declarations of intent to be a write-in candidate for state representatives and state senators in legislative districts wholly within Santa Fe county or composed of only one county shall be filed with the respective county clerk on Tuesday, March 15, 2016, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

TWO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC EDUCATION COMMISSION

DISTRICT 4: Santa Fe county precincts 11, 12, 15 through 19, 63, 72, 73, 80, 82, 84, 85 and 90. **FOUR-YEAR TERM**

No state convention for designating Primary Election candidates shall be held later than Sunday, March 13, 2016.

DISTRICT 10: Santa Fe county precincts 1 through 10, 13, 14, 20 through 62, 64 through 71, 74 through 79, 81, 83, and 86 through 89. **FOUR-YEAR TERM**

Certificates of Designation of Primary Election candidates shall be submitted by political parties to the Secretary of State no later than 5:00 p.m. on the first Tuesday succeeding the state convention.

ONE DISTRICT ATTORNEY

1st JUDICIAL DISTRICT **FOUR-YEAR TERM**

The Presidential Primary Election shall be held on the same date as the Primary Election in the State of New Mexico, June 7, 2016.

COUNTY OFFICES

SANTA FE COUNTY

The Presidential Primary Election shall be conducted and canvassed along with and in the manner provided by law for the conduct and canvassing of the Primary Election.
