Motion to authorize the County Manager, and other appropriate County staff, to engage in nonbinding negotiations with the Town of Edgewood for fire suppression services, fire prevention services, and emergency medical services, effective April 20, 2026.

In the event that negotiations are not completed by the end of the day on April 20, 2026, the Board authorizes the inclusion of five (5) community observers to attend negotiations in a non-participatory capacity, unless otherwise invited to respond to questions. Such observers shall be removed if they disrupt the proceedings.

The five (5) observers shall consist of two (2) representatives designated by Santa Fe County and three (3) representatives designated by the Town of Edgewood.

This provision shall apply only if agreement is not reached regarding third-party oversight and assurances related to payment obligations.

The Board further authorizes Commissioner Bustamante and the County Manager to designate the County's two (2) observers, with consideration given to individuals with relevant government and business experience in Edgewood.

If necessary, the County Attorney is authorized to establish ground rules and a reporting framework to ensure professionalism and transparency, including reporting back to the Board of County Commissioners, the Town Council, and the public.
