1. A. This meeting of the Santa Fe County Canvassing Board was called to order at approximately 2:20 p.m. by Chair Justin Greene in the County Commission Chambers, 102 Grant Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

**C. Approval of Agenda**

CHAIR GREENE: And we have an agenda. Are there any tweaks to the agenda by staff or by the board? Hearing none, can I get a motion to approve the agenda?

**E. Request Approval of the March 3, 2026, City of Española's Municipal Officer Election, Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-13-13(B).**

CHAIR GREENE: Rosangela, now it's your turn. Thank you.

ROSANGELA ORTIZ (Chief Deputy Bureau of Elections): Thank you. Chair, Commissioners, we are here to present the results of the municipal officer election and to do that we have Carla Martinez. She's the City Clerk of the City of Española. So the municipal officer election, the city clerk serves as the role that the county clerk would serve in elections. And we also have Steve from our office. So Steve Fresquez, he is our warehouse manager and voting systems expert. So he just passed out material. So I would like to hand over the microphone to Carla.

CARLA MARTINEZ (City of Española City Clerk): Thank you. Chairman Greene, Commissioners, it's a pleasure to be here with you all today. The packet that which just handed out are the canvassing reports that we printed out for you with the final tallies of the election result. The first page is the candidate summary and the number of votes that they did. Again, this is just for Santa Fe County, so this isn't the final tally.

The second page is the ballots cast, and that's broken down by precincts. The third attachment is the canvass of reports, and again, that's broken down by – the first page is the total and then broken down by precincts after that.

Also, we've provided you copies of past election results as well, just for your information.

CHAIR GREENE: Thank you very much. Any questions from the Board or anything else, Rosangela? From the Board?

First off, I guess one question is I see reports from district 1, 3, and 4 our nothing from district 2. Is that because district two fully sits within Rio Arriba?

MS. MARTINEZ: That's correct.

CHAIR GREENE: Thank you for clarifying that. And everything was smooth with your election up there?

MS. MARTINEZ: Yes.

CHAIR GREENE: Congratulations. Thanks for putting on a smooth, you know, a good successful election. Congratulations to all that won and everyone who competed in that. It takes a little bit of effort both to win and to lose. So it's appreciated for everybody.

Folks, anybody want to make a motion to approve these results?

COMMISSIONER BUSTAMANTE: Motion to approve the March 3<sup>rd</sup> election results.

COMMISSIONER HUGHES: I'll second

CHAIR GREENE: Motion from Commissioner Bustamante and second from Commissioner Hughes. All in favor say aye.

**The motion passed by unanimous voice vote.**

CHAIR GREENE: You have an election. Congratulations everybody.

MS. MARTINEZ: Thank you. I just want to make one comment and really thank the Catherine and her staff here at the Santa Fe County Clerk. Española is very unusual where we reside between two counties. So we have to work with Rio Arriba and Santa Fe County and try to be knowledgeable and conduct the election in the best way we can because not everything is done exactly in each county.

But Steve was an awesome resource supporter and the staff in the Clerk's Office, I am really grateful for them. This is my first election that I conducted, so there was certainly a learning curve and without them, this probably wouldn't have been possible to be where we at today. So thank you.

CHAIR GREENE: You're very welcome. Thanks for the kind words and yes, congratulations to Española and the community. Yes ma'am.

COMMISSIONER BUSTAMANTE: And thank you for what you do with that. Thank you for your good work.

MS. MARTINEZ: You're welcome.

CHAIR GREENE: Anybody else? Excellent. Well, great. Rosangela, did you have something? You looked like you wanted to say something.

MS. ORTIZ: We will be passing around the Certificate of Canvass results for signatures.


CHAIR GREENE: We will sign them dutifully and thank you very much. Congratulations, Española, congratulations Santa Fe County Clerks.


Having completed the agenda and with no further business to come before this body, Chair Greene declared this meeting adjourned at 2:27 p.m.
