VIII. MATTERS FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Mr. Kippenbrock reported that on June 12th they received the 20 year permit for BuRRT.

Everyone congratulated Mr. Kippenbrock.

IX. MATTERS FROM THE BOARD

Commissioner Hansen said all of her life she has recycled plastic bags and it is difficult now to know where to recycle them. We need to have a large container for this at the transfer station. It is an important thing. People would take the time to take them to the transfer station.

Chair Harris said he takes his to Albertsons. It is a good idea and relatively easy to do.

Ms. Sitton said the only people who take them are the people who distribute them. There is no market for them for us to collect unless there are very huge quantities. We have plastic bag ordinance in Santa Fe.

Mr. Kippenbrock said Walmart might be another avenue too.

Commissioner Hansen said she never goes there.

Mr. Eiger said Best Buy takes them.

Mr. Francisco said we don't have a container for them at the County transfer station because they are the last item to be recycled. That is what they make recycled stuff from.

Commissioner Hamilton asked for those who do take them, what do they do with them.

Ms. Sitton said they give them back to the bag manufacturer and they are reused.

Councilor Villarreal said we have the Ordinance but we still have plastic bags at the bulk section and the fruit and vegetable area.

Commissioner Hansen said she gets that it does not have any value but she hates to see them go into the trash. She is glad that the City has the plastic bag Ordinance.

Chair Harris asked Ms. Sitton how is the program going. It has been in place for 30 or 45 days now. There was one issue that was resolved pretty quickly.

Ms. Sitton said the program is going very well. We only have 1 month where we have been totally on carts. It looks good. May 2016 to May 2017 it shows collections up 38% for mixed recycling. When we have 2 months of data we will submit an update to the newspaper.

Chair Harris said single stream is great. On the glass side he uses the Siler location with those port holes but you can't dump the glass. You have to put it in piece by piece.

Ms. Sitton said those sites are unmanned. They are designed to avoid illegal recycling.

Chair Harris said he understands that.

Ms. Sitton said you can dump at BuRRT.

Councilor Hansen asked how much is it to dump hazardous waste like dyes.

Mr. Kippenbrock said bring to us and we will make a determination. Probably less than a \$1. The program is designed to keep it out of the landfill. There is no minimum charge. We want to encourage people to bring it in.

Commissioner Moreno said he has a flyer that has an amnesty date for hazardous waste. What does amnesty mean.

Mr. Kippenbrock said it means no questions asked.

Commissioner Moreno said he has a lot of half buckets of paint.

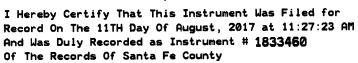
