# SANTA FE COUNTY INVESTMENT COMMETTEE MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 20, 2011

### Committee Members in attendance:

Victor A. Montoya, County Treasurer Virginia Vigil, Commission Chair Teresa Martinez, Finance Director Stephen Ross, County Attorney Katherine Miller, County Manager

## I. Meeting Called to Order:

- A motion to approve the June 30, 2011 minutes was made by Victor Montoya and seconded by Katherine Miller.
- A motion to approve the October 20, 2011 agenda was made by Victor Montoya and seconded by Teresa Martinez.
- Treasurer Montoya began the meeting with the first item on the agenda investment activity since the last Investment Committee Meeting on July 26, 2011.

There were so many Government Agencies purchased, instead of listing them I asked the Committee to refer to the portfolio report when we get to Agenda Item #3.

# 2. Property Tax Collections and Distributions:

- The \$958,007.58 in distributions collected for September 2011 property taxes will be made on October 20, 2011. The County's share for September 2011 collections is \$444,921.20. The maintenance report shows we have collected \$142,629,721.03 through September 30, 2011; through the eleventh month of 2010 tax collections. The tax collection rate through September 30, 2011 is 95.70%.
- Year-to-date collection rate September 30, 2011 over September 30, 2010 shows we are up 5.23%; and in dollars we are \$7,082,710.60 ahead of last year's collection.
- 3. Treasurer Montoya moved on to the next agenda item, the County's Investment Portfolio, followed by an explanation and discussion of the contents of the portfolio.
- 4. The next item addressed by the Treasurer was the status of the Local Government Investment Pool and the current balance of \$638.50. The Contingency Reserve still stands at \$271,864.21.
- 5. The Treasurer provided the Committee with a chart from Morgan Keegan's Fixed Income Research "Daily Market Update" information on the Treasury yield curve and yields on short term T-Bills.

6. The collection efforts of Adam Bailey on delinquent accounts for the fiscal year are as follows:

Through June 17, 2011 \$4,988,307.72 From June 18, 2011 through September 30, 2011 \$1,033,160.45 \$6,021,468.17

Gloria Apodaca collection efforts for the fiscal year are as follows: Through June 15, 2011 \$1,056,990.02

II. A <u>Verification Audit Report</u> of delinquent property tax payments from the Santa Fe County Treasurer's office was performed by TRD, Internal Audit Bureau. Correspondence from DFA Local Government, Budget & Finance Bureau indicates it's a draft and asked me to respond by October 17, 2011; I requested an extension to respond until November 4, 2011. (Copy of DFA letter was distributed to the Committee)

- First National Bank Account #186522491 (Santa Fe County by Land America Capitol City Title Services Inc. as Escrow Agent) Appears to be an interest bearing account no one from Santa Fe County authorized to sign; using Santa Fe County TIN.

These accounts were given to Ms. Teresa Martinez, Finance Director to research and provide update information on these accounts.
