Approval of Agenda

Attorney Boyd moved to approve the agenda and Commissioner Bustamante seconded. The motion is carried by unanimous [7-0] roll call vote.

Approval of March 20,2025 Meeting Minutes

Upon motion by Commissioner Bustamante, second by Eric Locks and unanimous [7-0] roll call vote, the March minutes were approved.

Results from Fiscal Agent/Transition Update

Treasurer Manzanares noted that the lockbox is still with Sunflower.

Treasurer Manzanares informed the committee that we have had a lot more interaction with US Bank, successfully running payroll, upcoming property taxes information, and accounts for the county. Treasurer Manzanares is working on closing all other accounts with Sunflower Bank.

Deputy Treasurer Olaechea stated that there has been issues with US Bank pertaining to ACH and wires. Santa County is learning how US Bank handles these account transactions. Deputy Treasurer Olaechea informed the ICM we are still doing transactions with both banks. Mrs. Munoz Lucero agreed with Deputy Treasurer Olaechea on going through the process and learning as we go.

Deputy Cordova asked Deputy Treasurer Olaechea if he had found out about the high fees that US Bank had been charging Santa Fe County. Deputy Treasurer Olaechea informed the committee as our amounts grow in our accounts the fees will drop.

Board of Finance Approval of LGIP

Treasurer Manzanares stated that we are set up with LGIP. Manager Shaffer noted that given the competitive environment it makes sense to use the LGIP until an investment advisor is brought on board since it has 4.5 percent interest and reasonable liquidity. Manager Schaffer also stated that the LGIP is much easier to manage cash and for liquidity. Treasurer Manzanares stated she has been in contact with Director Herrera assuring liquidity with the upcoming SF County projects.

State of the Economy

Treasurer Manzanares stated that Deputy Treasurer Olaechea and herself have been moving very cautiously into making investment decisions with anything that has been maturing for the County. Treasurer Manzanares and Deputy Treasurer Olaechea have been in conversations with the Broker Dealers regarding current investments.

Treasurer's Office Updates

Treasurer Manzanares informed the committee that we have chosen a merchant service. Point & Pay. They have a 60-day implementation period. Been meeting with them weekly so that our taxpayer will be satisfied with our decision as we move into the tax season now in June.

Treasurer Manzanares let the committee know that we had an RFP for Printing Services. Automated Elections has been awarded the contract. Automated oversees printing property tax bills, delinquent notices etc.

Treasurer Manzanares stated that we are looking for a cashier and looking for some changes in the offices of positions changing.

Treasurer Manzanares informed the committee of the Treasures Affiliate Fall Conference. It will be held at the Hilton Downtown Santa Fe. Starting August 25th through the 29th. We expect many counties will be attending the conference. Santa Fe County is looking forward to hosting many wonderful speakers, activities that will be offered, as well as learning from one another. Thank You to all the team for all the hard work they have been putting in.

Portfolio Balances

Deputy Treasurer Olaechea said he lacks access to all the accounts, however, the Sunflower account has approximately \$37 million left in it.

Deputy Treasurer Olaechea indicated that Mesirow account has been closed and the money was moved into the custodial account. .


