

341 Caja Del Rio Rd.**

FROM HWY 285 NORTH OF SANTA FE:


- Take Hwy 599 exit; go south for 3.4 miles
- Exit at Camino la Tierra; go north (right) for 2.5 miles
- Bear right onto Las Campanas Drive; go 3.5 miles
- Turn left on Caja Del Rio (at stop sign); go 0.5 miles to BRWTP entrance
- Turn right into BRWTP

FROM I-25 SOUTH OF SANTA FE:

- Take Hwy 599 exit; go north for 5.9 miles
- Turn left on Road 62 then make immediate left at the "T" (heading back in the direction you just came from on the 599 frontage road)
- On 599 frontage road go 1.5 miles
- Turn right on Caja Del Rio; go 3.4 miles to BRWTP entrance
- Turn left into BRWTP

FROM HWY 285 NORTH OF SANTA FE:
