WORK PLAN

The Santa Fe County Independent Salary Commission (“ISC”) was created by Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners through enactment of Santa Fe County Resolution No. 2025-054, recorded May 20 , 2025. The ISC met on November 7, 14, and 21, 2025, and timely submitted its Report and Recommendations to the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners (“BCC”) on December 1, 2025, followed by an in-person presentation to the BCC by ISC members on December 15, 2025. The BCC unanimously adopted the ISC Report And Recommendations on December 15, 2025, effective January 1, 2026.

At its March 4, 2026, Special Meeting, the ISC discussed what should be included in its 2026 Work Plan and made the following recommendations to be forwarded to the BCC for its consideration:

1. Future study to justify the recommended salaries for each Non-Commissioner.
2. Should the Commission Chair receive an extra compensation/stipend of \$2,000 annually while serving as Chair?
3. Consider the issue of the "revolving door" of Department Deputies supervised by the Elected Non-Commissioners trading positions with Elected Non-Commissioners upon expiration of their term of office.
4. Identifying roles and responsibilities for each Elected Official to be publicly posted by the County Human Resources Department with the goal of creating transparency and to educate the public on each Elected Officials' role.
5. Mechanisms for ongoing salary increases (COLA's) in accordance with applicable New Mexico law (e.g. Article IV, Section 27 of the NM Constitution, which states that no extra compensation, either increase or decrease, shall be given to any public officer during his or her term of office.
