SUMMARY

Staff is requesting approval of the resolution in support of participation in the 2018/2019 NMDOT Local Government Road Fund (LGRF) Program which provides funds to local entities for pavement rehabilitation and improvements.

BACKGROUND

Public Works was approved for funding through the LGRF Program SB funding for the pavement rehabilitation/improvements for various County Roads in Santa Fe County, New Mexico. Santa Fe County is required to provide 25% in matching funds in the amount of \$32,686.00 with the State's share of 75% in the amount of \$98,058.00 for a total project cost of \$130,744.00.




