

**ITEM AND ISSUE:** *BCC Meeting October 30, 2018*

**Ordinance No. 2018 - \_\_\_\_\_, An Ordinance Amending Santa Fe County Ordinance No. 2014-10 ("Solid Waste and Recycling Management Ordinance") to Reduce the Cost of Using County Convenience Centers. (Public Works Department/Robert Martinez)(Final Public Hearing)**

### SUMMARY:

The referenced ordinance: 1) eliminates the permit fee increase scheduled to take place on January 1, 2019, as per Ordinance 2014-10, 2) reduces the current 6 trip permit fee from \$70.00 to \$55.00, 3) adds a 3 trip permit for \$27.50, and 4) places a permit expiration date of the end of the calendar year.

### BACKGROUND:

At the September 11, 2018 meeting, the Board of County Commissioners directed staff to schedule the referenced ordinance for 2 public hearings and possible action at the October 30, 2018 BCC meeting. The first public hearing was held on October 9, 2018. The October 30<sup>th</sup> hearing was legally noticed in the October 16, 2018 Albuquerque Journal.

Ordinance 2014-10, set scheduled permit fee increases over a 5 year period in order to achieve 30% recovery of solid waste maintenance and operations costs through permit sales. The 2019 fee increase is the final scheduled increase as per the ordinance. The permit Fees are as follows:

	<u>Current Fee:</u>	<u>2019 Scheduled Fee Increase:</u>
Bag Tags	\$9	\$10
1 trip permit	\$18	\$19
6 trip permit	\$70	\$95
12 trip permit	\$110	\$140

Low income, senior citizen, or veteran discounts are available to eligible residents for a \$5 reduced fee for a 6 trip permit and \$10 reduced fee for a 12 trip permit. Residents are eligible for only one reduced fee.

Conduct the final public hearing.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SANTA FE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2014-10  
("SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE") TO REDUCE  
THE COST OF USING COUNTY CONVENIENCE CENTERS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE  
COUNTY THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2014-10 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 13(A) is amended to repeal and replace section 1 as follows:

1. Solid Waste Permits consist of a 12 Trip Punch Permit, 6 Trip Punch Permit, 3 Trip Punch Permit, 1 Trip Permit, and Bag Tags. Permits expire at the end of the calendar year in which they are issued. Permits must be obtained and purchased in advance of use at the Convenience Centers and are non-refundable.

**Section 2.** Section 13(B) is repealed and replaced with the following:

**(B) Schedule of Solid Waste Permit Fees**

- (1) 12 Trip Punch Permit: \$110.00
- (2) 6 Trip Punch Permit: \$55.00
- (3) 3 Trip Punch Permit: \$27.50
- (4) 1 Trip Permit: \$18.00
- (5) 5 Bag Tags: \$9.00

**Section 3.** Section 13 is amended to add the following section C:

(C) This amendment shall not have any impact or effect on Trip Punch Permits, Trip Permits, and Bag Tags purchased prior to the effective date of this amendment.

**Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after it is recorded by the County Clerk, pursuant to NMSA 1978, § 4-37-9.
