ORDINANCE 2012- , AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-5. SECTION 13, PARAGRAPH (A)(1) TO EXTEND THE TIME DURING WHICH PERMITS WILL REMAIN VALID, AND SECTION 13, PARAGRAPH (A)(4) TO SUSPEND SCHEDULED FEE INCREASES FOR RESIDENTS OUTSIDE OF INCORPORATED AREAS FOR TWENTY-FOUR TRIP PERMITS FOR FY 13 AND THEREAFTER (Public Works/Robert Martinez) FINAL PUBLIC HEARING

BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY:

As previously directed by the BCC, to evaluate the existing solid waste fee structure, staff is recommending that the existing ordinance governing the solid waste program be amended. The recommended amendments are to impose a moratorium, which will indefinitely suspend fee increases for residents outside of incorporated areas for (24) twenty-four trip permits for FY 13 and thereafter. Staff is also recommending that the 2012, solid waste permit expiration date be extended for an additional (30) thirty days.

It is anticipated that the newly created Solid Waste Task Force will present its findings and recommendations to the BCC in December 2012.

ACTION REQUESTED:

Request adoption of an ordinance amending Ordinance 2010-5, "The solid Waste Management Ordinance", to revise the solid waste fee permit structure.

ORDINANCE NO. 2012 –

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-5, SECTION 13, PARAGRAPH (A)(1) TO EXTEND THE TIME DURING WHICH PERMITS WILL REMAIN VALID, AND SECTION 13, PARAGRAPH (A)(4) TO SUSPEND SCHEDULED FEE INCREASES FOR RESIDENTS OUTSIDE OF INCORPORATED AREAS FOR TWENTY-FOUR TRIP PERMITS FOR FY 13 AND THEREAFTER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY THAT SECTION 13, SERVICE FEES, PARAGRAPHS (A)(1) AND (A)(4) OF ORDINANCE NO. 2010-5 ARE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Amendment of Section 13(A)(1) of Ordinance 2010-5:

The second to the last sentence of Section 13(A)(1) is repealed and replaced with the following:

"Residential Solid Waste Permits are valid for thirty days after the year printed on the permit."

Section Two. Amendment of Section 13(A)(4) of Ordinance 2009-5:

Section 13(A)(4) (Schedule of Residential Solid Waste Permit Fees for Residents Outside of Incorporated Areas) is amended to indefinitely suspend fee increases for residents outside of incorporate areas for twenty-four trip permits for FY 13 and thereafter.

Section Three. Effective Date.

This Amendment shall become effective thirty days after recordation pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 4-37-9(1975).
