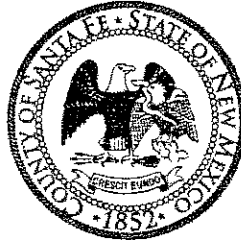

Request Authorization to Publish Title and General Summary of Ordinance No. 2018 - _____, An Ordinance Amending Santa Fe County Ordinance No. 2014-10 ("Solid Waste and Recycling Management Ordinance") to Reduce the Cost of Using County Convenience Centers. (Public Works Department/Robert Martinez)

SUMMARY:

The current solid waste ordinance includes a permit fee schedule that will increase permit fees on January 1, 2019.

BACKGROUND:

Staff is requesting to publish title and general summary of an ordinance amending the current solid waste ordinance. At the August 14, 2018 Board of County Commission meeting, staff received direction from the Board to possibly offer alternate permit options, reduce permit fees and suspend the scheduled permit fee increase that will take place on January 1, 2019.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SANTA FE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2014-10
("SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE") TO REDUCE
THE COST OF USING COUNTY CONVENIENCE CENTERS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2014-10 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 13(A) is amended to repeal and replace section 1 as follows:

1. Solid Waste Permits consist of a 12 Trip Punch Permit, 6 Trip Punch Permit, 3 Trip Punch Permit, 1 Trip Permit, and Bag Tags. Permits expire at the end of the calendar year in which they are issued. Permits must be obtained and purchased in advance of use at the Convenience Centers and are non-refundable.

Section 2. Section 13(B) is repealed and replaced with the following:

(B) Schedule of Solid Waste Permit Fees

- (1) 12 Trip Punch Permit: \$110.00
- (2) 6 Trip Punch Permit: \$55.00
- (3) 3 Trip Punch Permit: \$27.50
- (4) 1 Trip Permit: \$18.00
- (5) 5 Bag Tags: \$9.00

Section 3. Section 13 is amended to the following section C:

(C) This amendment shall not have any impact or effect on Trip Punch Permits, Trip Permits, and Bag Tags purchased prior to the effective date of this amendment.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after it is recorded by the County Clerk, pursuant to NMSA 1978, § 4-37-9.
