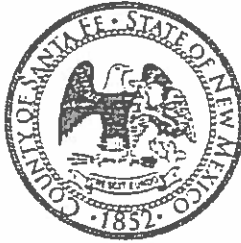

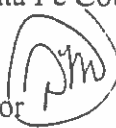

Subject: Resolution No. 2016-_____, A Resolution Requesting A Budget Increase To The Alcohol Programs Fund (241) To Budget Compliance Fees Collected From DWI Offenders Participating In The Compliance Monitoring Program/ \$163,800.00. (Finance Division/ Don Moya)

Issue:

Request approval of a Resolution for a budget increase to the Alcohol Programs Fund (241) by \$163,800.00 through a compliance fee collected from DWI Offenders participating in the Compliance Monitoring Program.

Background:

State Statute Section 31-20-5.1 NMSA 1978 authorizes judges to order a defendant to pay from \$15 to \$50 per month in fees to be used to operate a DWI Compliance Program. The fee shall be stated in the court order and shall be paid by the defendant directly to the county where the supervising Compliance Monitoring program is located. The Santa Fe Magistrate Court started imposing the fee in August 2014 at the request of the Santa Fe County DWI program. To date the County DWI program has collect \$163,800.00.

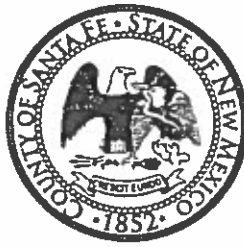

Resolution No. 2016-_____, A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO INITIATE AND PROSECUTE CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS TO ACQUIRE PARCEL 16 FOR THE SANTA FE RIVER GREENWAY PROJECT (Public Works/Mark Hogan)

SUMMARY:

All Parcels except for Parcel 16 have been acquired or are under contract for Section "A" (Frenchy's to Siler) of the Santa Fe River Greenway Project. Parcel 16 is an Overlap Parcel consisting of 1,044 square feet of land and valued at \$2,180.00 and is claimed by Larry Boylan and Peter & Rosemary Padilla. Dawson Surveys, the County's surveyor for the Greenway Project, has been unable to assign clear ownership to either party based on existing documentation, plats, deeds and surveys. On October 13th, the County paid Larry Boylan \$1,090.00 for his 50% interest in the property.

BACKGROUND:

The County and its consultant, Tierra Right of Way Services, have made multiple attempts to contact and work with Peter & Rosemary Padilla. Staff last met with Peter & Rosemary Padilla on September 30, 2016. They were responding to a final letter staff wrote to them requesting they talk to the County before the County was forced to take alternate actions to acquire the overlap parcel. On October 12th the Padilla's offered to trade a Quit Claim Deed to an adjacent Parcel 17, a land parcel to which they have no claim to the County for the County's interest in Parcel 16. The County responded that they could not accept that parcel to settle the subject overlap. Mr. Padilla has been unavailable for further efforts to resolve this acquisition.

ACTION REQUESTED:

The Greenway River Project staff, having exhausted all other options, now request the authorization to prosecute condemnation proceedings to complete this necessary acquisition.

**A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO INITIATE AND PROSECUTE
CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS TO ACQUIRE PARCEL 16 FOR THE SANTA FE
RIVER GREENWAY PROJECT**

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2014-125, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) of Santa Fe County (County) delegated to the County Manager the authority to acquire, through negotiated sale, suitable real property interests for the construction of the Santa Fe River Greenway Project (Project) from Frenchy's Field to Siler Road (the Project Area); and

WHEREAS, the County Manager has acquired on behalf of the County or is under contract to acquire all necessary properties within the Project Area except the property identified as Parcel 16, as described on Exhibit A to this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the owner of Parcel 16 has not responded to the County Manager's offer to purchase and has otherwise refused to negotiate an amicable purchase and sale agreement with County staff; and

WHEREAS, the County is constructing the Project for a public purpose and acquisition of Parcel 16 is essential to completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, further delay in acquiring Parcel 16 will unreasonably delay completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, to avoid further delay, the Board desires to authorize the County Attorney to initiate and prosecute condemnation proceedings on behalf of the County to timely obtain Parcel 16.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby authorizes the County Attorney to initiate and prosecute condemnation proceedings to acquire Parcel 16, as identified on Exhibit A hereto; *provided*, however, that the County Attorney shall not initiate such proceedings, or shall dismiss the proceedings after initiation, upon execution of a negotiated purchase and sale agreement by the County Manager.

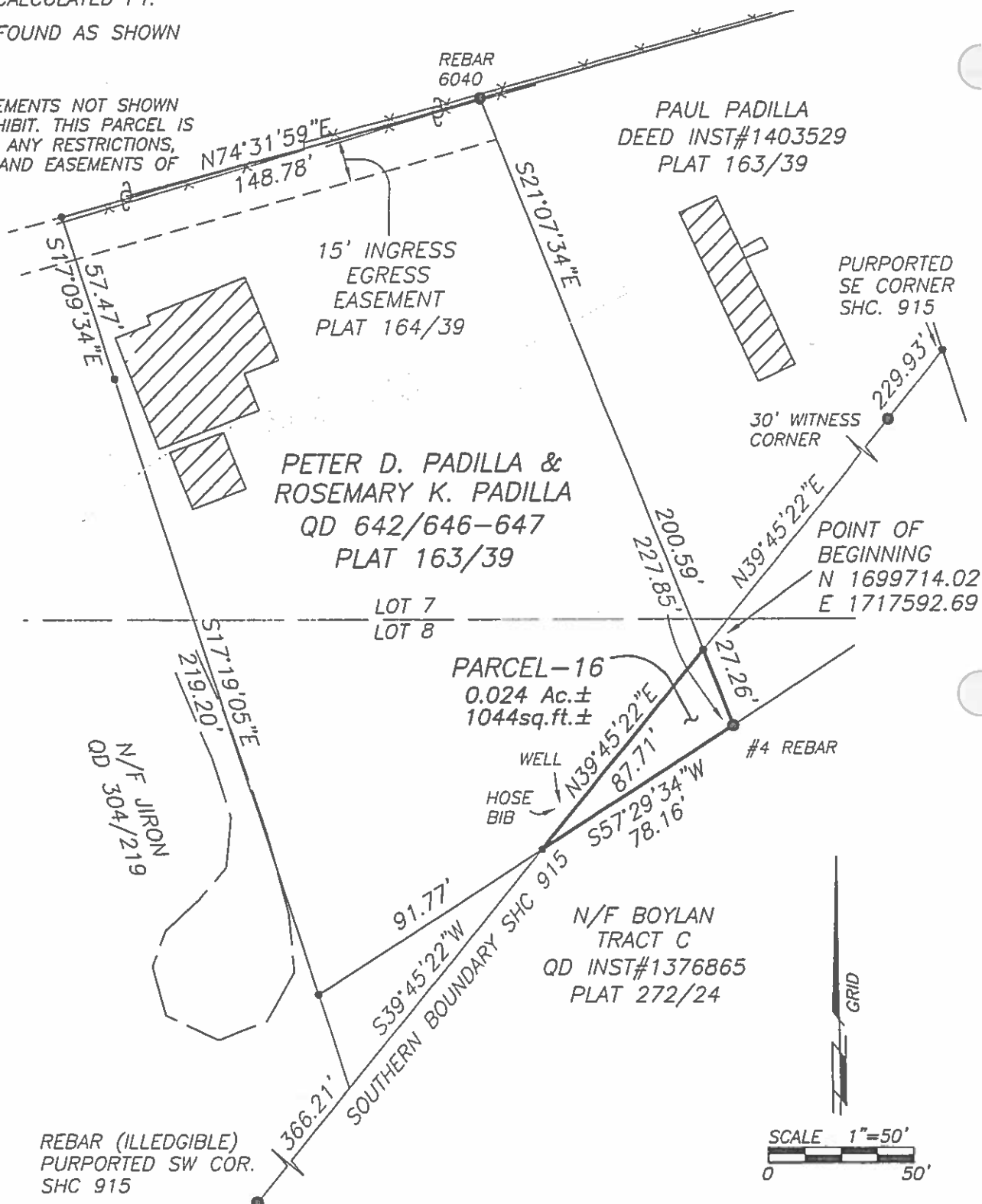
