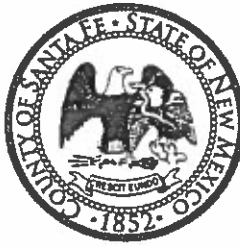

Subject: Appointment of two Santa Fe County Ethics Board Members

Background and Summary

The Santa Fe County Ethics Board (Board) consists of five members who are appointed by the Board of County Commission, and whose primary duties are to enforce the County Code of Conduct Ordinance. Each Board member shall serve a two year term, subject to reappointment thereafter.

Members shall not be employed by the State, a political subdivision, or a school district, shall not hold an elective public office, and must be registered to vote in Santa Fe County. All of the Board positions are At-Large positions and do not represent a specific Commission District.

Currently the Board has two (2) vacancies for the term February 24, 2015 – February 23, 2017, and as part of the normal process, staff advertised a “call for interested applicants” via three press releases and within two Commissioner Newsletters.

As a result of these efforts, the County received applications, resumes and conflict of interest forms from the following individuals:

All applicants meet the requirements of the Ordinance and as part of the normal vetting process, staff met with each applicant to ascertain their understanding of the Board’s responsibilities and duties and to gauge their availability to serve on the Board.

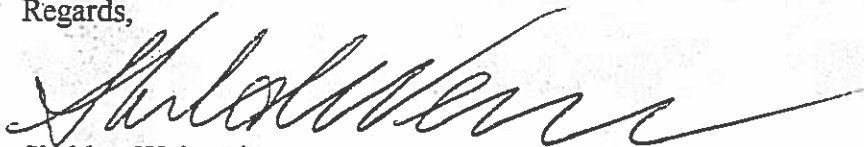
Enclosed please find my resume, for the voluntary position currently available on the Santa Fe County Board of Ethics.

Request Appointment of Members to the La Bajada Ranch Steering Committee. (Public Works Department/Mark Hogan)

BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY:

On October 30, 2012 the BCC approved the appointment of Fourteen (14) Members to the Steering Committee for La Bajada Ranch. The purpose of the committee is to review development proposals for the ranch and to make recommendations ~~and~~ to the Board of County Commissioners for how the County property can best be utilized in meeting the objectives of the enabling resolution.

Resolution 2012-106 specifies that the BCC shall appoint thirteen (13) members to the committee. The fourteenth (14th) member shall be the commissioner from District 3. Six (6) of the initial appointments shall serve a two (2) year term, and the remaining seven (7) appointments shall serve a three year term. As of December 2014 (5) of the (14) appointments terms have expired, including that of Commissioner Kathy Holian from District 3.

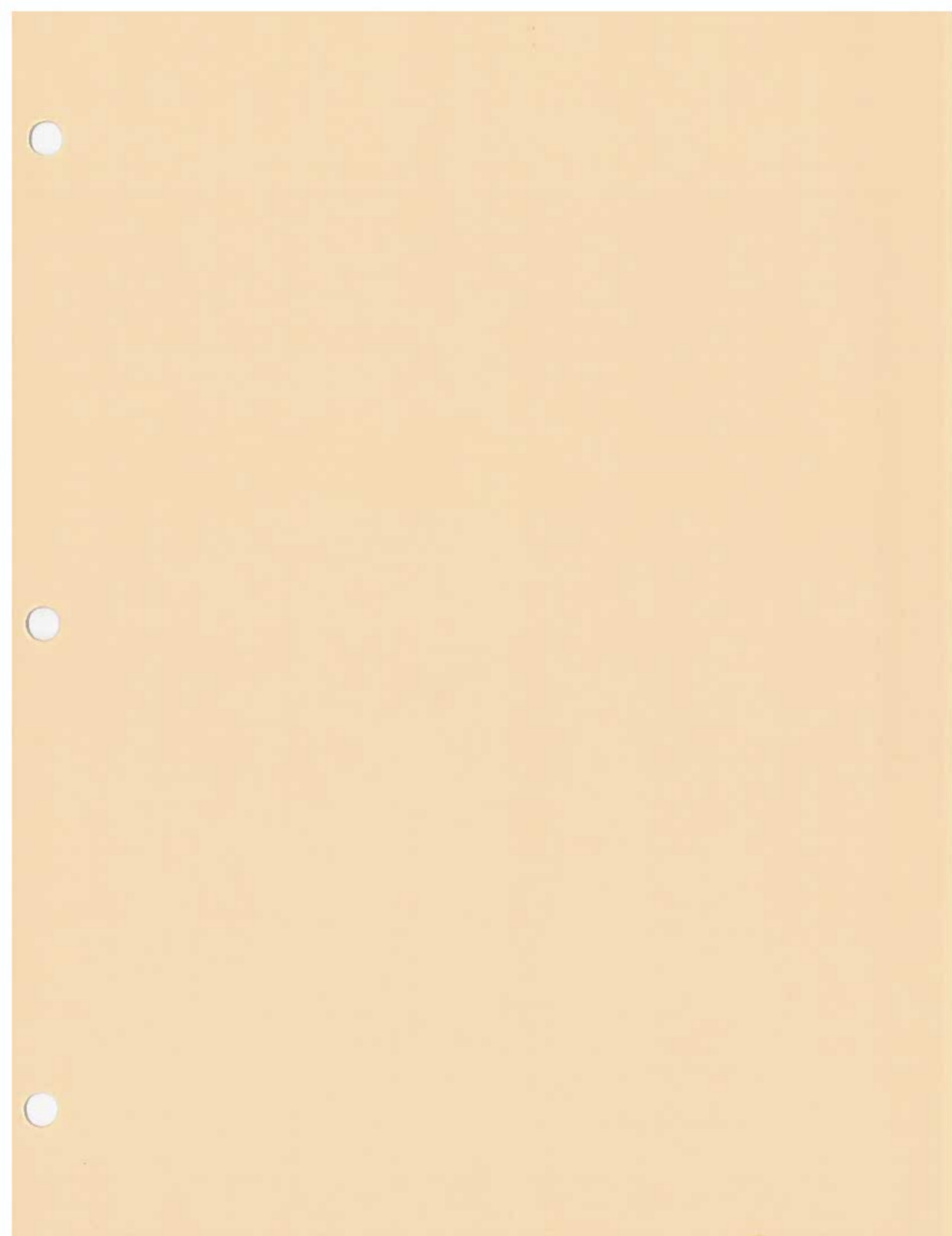

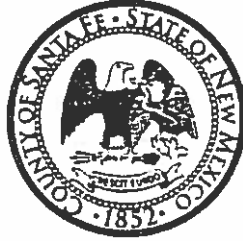

(Finance/Teresa Martinez)**

ISSUE:

The Finance Division is seeking approval to adjust various funds' budgets (General Fund - 101, Fire Tax ¼% Fund - 222, Fire Operations Fund - 244, Emergency Communications Fund - 245, Corrections Operations Fund - 247, and Water Enterprise Fund - 505). Adjustments to these budgets are being requested as a result of needs brought forward by departments at the FY2015 Mid-Year Budget Hearings.

BACKGROUND:

Between January 22 and January 30, 2015 the Finance Division conducted Mid-Year Budget Hearings. The Finance Division met individually with all Elected Offices and Department/Divisions to discuss the status of each budget and any needs or changes that were required. As a result of these hearings a number of adjustments are being requested to address those needs.

FTE Requests

The Community Services Department / Senior Services Division is requesting to increase a part-time Driver/Cooks' Assistant and a part-time Cook's Assistant to full-time status and reclassify a part-time Senior Companion Program Coordinator to a Driver and increase to full-time status which would equal a total increase of 1.5 FTEs.

These FTE increases are requested due to the increased services for Congregate and Home Delivered which have increased by over 150% from FY2012 to FY2014 and for Transportation services which have increased over 30% for the same time period. This expansion of services will be funded through vacancy savings for the Senior Services program for FY 2015.

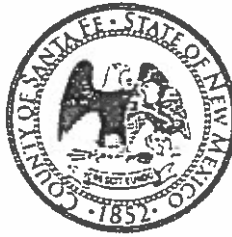

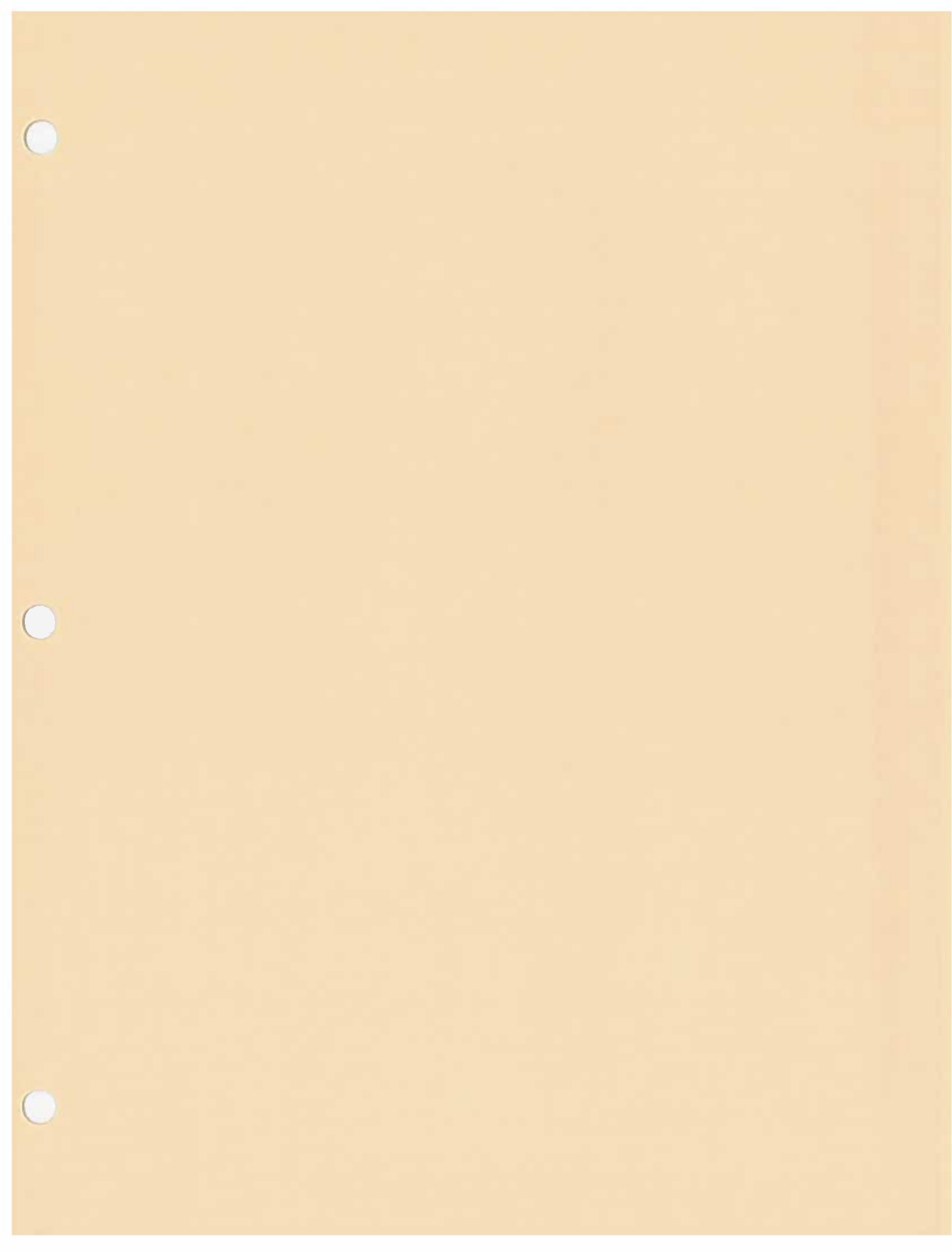

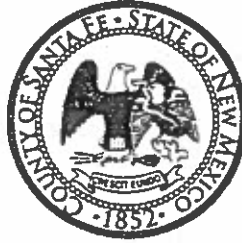

SUMMARY:

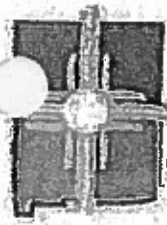

Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 66-6-23 (1999), which states, the Board of County Commissioners of each county shall certify and submit an Annual Certified County Maintained Mileage Report to the Secretary of the Department of Transportation, on or before April 1st of each year.

By July 1st of every year, representatives for the Secretary of the Department of Transportation shall verify the submittal of each county and revise, if necessary, the total mileage of public roads maintained by each county. The mileage acknowledged by these representatives, shall be the official mileage of the public roads maintained by each county and will be reported to the New Mexico State Treasurer's Office. After August 1st, distribution of funding to each county for road maintenance purposes shall be made in accordance with the aforementioned NMSA section.

Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 67-3-28.3 (1988), any county not complying with the required certified submittal by April 1st of each year, will have their mileage estimated and then reduced by one-third each month for that fiscal year, by the Secretary of the Department of Transportation. The amount of mileage deducted from the counties not in compliance, shall be equally distributed between all counties in compliance, by the Secretary of the Department of Transportation.

Please submit a complete set of information, correctly labeled and identified which contains the following:

- 1) A fully attributed Geographic Information System (GIS) data set identifying certified county maintained road features with mileage information on CD. The recent state funded effort to collect E-911 County Global Positioning System (GPS) road data can be used to satisfy this option. The NMDOT updates its database with the county submitted data and information, annually.

Note: The New Mexico Department of Transportation utilizes the following GIS and CADD software packages:

- a. ArcGIS 9.X or 10.x .mxd. Information must include layer definition (.lyr) files, geodatabases or shape files containing all related files (e.g., .shp, .dbf, .prj, .sbn, .sbx, .shx, .xml). Provide metadata and projection information, symbology for data, and export to a .pdf file.
- b. AutoCAD 2002 - 2013 (.dwg or .dxf files) or MicroStation v.8 or v.8i, .dgn files.
- c. PDF File for map(s) and Microsoft Word or Excel for route listing.

If you are currently utilizing a GIS software package not listed above, or have further questions please contact us at the below listed phone numbers.

As the NMDOT is also working towards the creation and verification of a statewide "All Public Roads" network, should your county have additional line work and associated tabular data on roads within your county that are not county maintained, please feel free to provide that information along with your submittal. While not required, this additional information would assist us greatly.

2) A package to include either a hard copy or a digital spreadsheet or document that was used to generate a Route Listing and County Map(s). The digital data can be provided on CD or diskette and should be in a standard application format such as MS Excel or MS Word. For legal purposes, please ensure that the Administrative Resolution, the Route Listing and the Map are labeled with the corresponding year of the submittal.

WHEREAS, horses and equine activity have been a unique, integral part of Santa Fe County's history and culture for over 400 years;

WHEREAS, Santa Fe's historic development as a transportation hub and government center could not have taken place without the significant contributions of equines;

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County adopted the Sustainable Growth Management Plan (SGMP) in 2010, in which Section 5.3.1.4, entitled "Historic Road Network, Scenic Roads and Byways," identifies the equine's historic contributions to the delivery of goods and transportation of people using the Old Santa Fe Trail and the Old Spanish Trail, which trail alone was used to transport thousands of horses at a time from California to Santa Fe;

WHEREAS, equine activities have a substantial economic impact in Santa Fe County;

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County adopted the SGMP in 2010, which identifies Agriculture, Arts & Culture and Ecotourism & Outdoor Recreation as 3 of the 6 Target Industries for economic development;

WHEREAS, SGMP Section 4.2.2.1, entitled "Agricultural Production," identifies that "According to the 1998 Agriculture and Ranching study commissioned by Santa Fe County...in "[c]attle and horses made up the majority of the common livestock." Within the agriculture/cattle industry, horses are traditionally used for gathering and sorting cattle;

WHEREAS, SGMP Section 3.2.4.2, entitled "Arts and Culture," identifies "horseback riding" among a number of outdoor naturalistic pursuits that draw significant numbers of tourists to Santa Fe County;

WHEREAS, SGMP Section 3.2.4.5, identifies "horseback riding" as a form of Ecotourism/Outdoor Recreation;

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Economic Development Strategic Plan, at Section 1.6.3, states that "Agritourism (bringing visitors to a farm or ranch) is a growing part of the national economy that generates over \$556 million in revenues for US farmers each year...[and that]..."The equestrian industry is an important component of the Santa Fe County economy, with over 500 members represented in the Santa Fe County Horse Coalition."; and

WHEREAS, horse facilities, trails and training grounds provide a robust infrastructure for clinics, agritourism and overall health/wellness for Santa Fe County residents and tourists alike.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County:

1. Recognize the historic, cultural and economic importance of horses within Santa Fe County;
2. Collaborate with appropriate stakeholders, including the Santa Fe County Horse Coalition to promote economic growth through horse activities;
3. Support the development and maintenance of facilities and businesses that will enable horse-related economic growth;
4. Protect and preserve the equine culture in the final development and implementation of the SLDC, and acknowledge the County's support of the development of Santa Fe County as a regional and international horse destination; and
5. Will consider the need to include equine uses and equine related businesses in future County plans and plan updates.

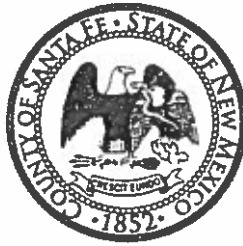

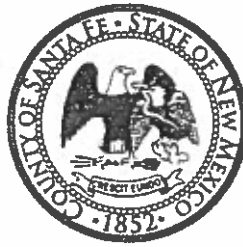

WHEREAS, fresco paintings figure prominently at the Santa Fe County Administrative Building, and installation of other fresco paintings at other Santa Fe County buildings would create a consistent theme; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County's artistic and cultural tourism organizations are key components of a vibrant community and further enhance the quality of life, and their continued existence should be encouraged and supported; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County is a place where nationally recognized events occur and a Three Trails Conference has been scheduled for September 17-20, 2015, to bring together three (3) nonprofit organizations dedicated to the commemoration of three historic Santa Fe County trails: the Santa Fe Trail Association (SFTA), the Old Spanish Trail Association (OSTA), and El Camino Real de Tierra Adentro Trail Association (CARTA); and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County desires to coordinate efforts to foster arts and cultural tourism activities; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County intends to develop the old First Judicial District Courthouse located on Catron Street into a new County Complex Building;
