Resolution No. 2017-\_\_\_\_\_, A Resolution Delegating Authority To The County Manager To Negotiate And Execute All Documents Necessary For The Conveyance Of Property Located At 19 And 23 East Frontage Road, Edgewood, NM (Public Works/Terry Lease)

## SUMMARY:

In 2014 the County vacated a former fire station located at 19 and 23 East Frontage Road, Edgewood, New Mexico ("Property"). The Town of Edgewood ("Town") would now like to make a substantial investment to remodel one of the buildings on the Property to accommodate the Edgewood Police Department and other Town staff. The Town is not in a position to both purchase the Property and pay for the remodeling of the building, so the Town has requested that the County convey ownership of the Property to the Town for one dollar.

### **BACKGROUND:**

In August of 2014 the Santa Fe County Fire Department moved into the newly constructed Fire Station #1 and vacated the old station. Shortly thereafter, the Town leased two small support buildings on the Property and the former fire station building has remained vacant. If the Town successfully acquires the Property, they could then invest approximately \$500,000 to remodel the fire station building to accommodate its police department and other Town staff. The Town's police department has outgrown its current location and relocating to the remodeled building would allow for more efficient operation of the police department. The police department's current location would then accommodate expanded operations of the Town's municipal court. The County has no use for the Property and conveying ownership of it to the Town would be in the best interest of the citizens of Santa Fe County.



## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:



#### SUMMARY:

The purpose of this resolution is to facilitate the acquisition of real property interests for the Eldorado Fire Station No. 4.

## BACKGROUND and DISCUSSION:

In the FY2017-2021 Capital Improvement Plan request to the New Mexico Legislature the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners included a project for the acquisition of real property and the planning and design of a fire station to be known as the Eldorado Fire Station #4 ("Project"). The 2016 Legislature appropriated \$105,500.00 for the Project (16-A2503) and the appropriation was accepted by the County on September 27, 2016. Using criteria such as size, proximity to other fire stations, access to paved roads and availability of utilities, County staff conducted an extensive search of properties in the Eldorado subdivision. WHEREAS, the County's acquisition of the Property will allow the County to proceed with the planning and design of the Project.


## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:
